How the gospel is watered down, that many Christians that have been Christians for a long time have just been sitting there- not growing, not hearing the truth, etc...

I believe they really see it now. I believe they are on their way- that some blinders have been lifted off. AND IT TOOK THEM LISTENING TO THE SERMONS AND COMPILATIONS. Praise God!
