I also think that this 23rd chapter of Jeremiah speaks so mightily to those same things as well.

Brother, I have felt the same thing, that, as you put it "Being a doomsayer doesn't make one more righteous than a prosperity preacher."

I do not think there is anything particularly righteous about shouting, or being angry, or even zealous in preaching, or for that matter using harsh words or speech, or pronouncing judgements, **in and of themselves**.

The Scripture says of the Lord Jesus in the prophets

"Behold my servant, whom I uphold; mine elect, in whom my soul delighteth; I have put my spirit upon him: he shall bring forth judgment to the Gentiles. He shall not cry, nor lift up, nor cause his voice to be heard in the street. A bruised reed s

shall he not break, and the smoking flax shall he not quench: he shall bring forth judgment unto truth."

Where is our power: is it in the **volume** of our words? Or in the power and might of the Holy Spirit?

The Lord Jesus said of the Holy Spirit

**And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment**

Someone recently recommend to me to "stay within what God gives you to say or pray for people. He is well able to do far more with the right words, than with the wrong ones."

I am weak and unable to do this on my own but may God be my help.

Our blessed Lord has said

**I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me.**
