Just some scripture that may coincide with the beasts of the sea and earth.

As to the beast from the sea,

"And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the th ird part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters; And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter." (REV 8:10-11)

"And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried a way of the flood." (REV 12:15)

"And he saith unto me, The waters which thou sawest, where the whore sitteth, are peoples, and multitudes, and nati ons, and tongues." (REV 17:15)

As for the Earth,

"And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bot tomless pit. Rev 13:1 And I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and on his horns ten diade ms, and on its heads names of blasphemy.

:4 The first was like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from

- **:6** After this I beheld, and lo another, like a leopard, which had upon the back of it four wings of a fowl; the beast had als o four heads; and dominion was given to it Babylon is the lion, (Persia is the bear, leopard is Greece)
- :3 And I saw one of its heads, as having been slain to death, and its deadly wound was healed. And all the earth wonder ed after the beast.
