Recommendation 666

More political intrigue was to come. On June 5, 2000, the 10 WEU nations adopted their Assembly Recommendation 666. The importance of this document was to recommend to the Council of the European Union that the 10 Brussels Treaty powers should be kept together as the EU’s new military wing. It also recommended giving the High Representative emergency powers — powers even the EU’s president doesn’t have. Since Solana was Secretary General of both the WEU and the Council, Recommendation 666 was actually Solana recommending action to Solana. We learned of Recommendation 666 and then on further internet searching that his job was created with Section 666 of the codified European documents.

Paragraph 12 which proposed giving Solana control over the emergency management machinery for Europe, chairmanship of the Political Security Committee (PSC), and “power to convene the Council of the European Union in the event of an emergency.”

Paragraph 15 which referred to the CIMIC concept: “Civil Military Cooperation” reminding me so very much of the old expression attributed in World War II to Nazified German concepts of “You will cooperate, you will enjoy!”

Paragraph 18 which had to do with the Torrejon space center.

The USA had “nothing like it,” said Dr. Solana. Further statements down the road indicated that the project’s sophistication was such that a blind European would be able to go through European subways “completely unaided by any external device.”

The ENP was implemented under existing funding instruments. However, the existing instruments were not sufficient to meet the ENP’s goals. On January 1, 2007 Solana was tasked with creating a new funding instrument — the European Neighborhood and Partnership Instrument (ENPI). What’s prophetically significant is that the ENPI is a seven-year funding instrument with a built in checkpoint.

Real ID Act - The Real ID ACT passed May 11, 2008, in the U.S. Senate.

The European Union is creating the same form of radio readable ID, currently there is 186 countries out of 192 who are prepared to go with this type of ID. I believe this a precursor to a funding instrument that will soon be introduced. Collages and some high schools and middle schools have IDs. Do your kids have ID? All maritime people and petro chemical employees must have a TWIK card which is the same kind of card.

James Wilson quote:

What are those virtues? They are chiefly the same virtues, which we have already seen to be descriptive of the American character; the love of liberty, and the love of law. But law and liberty cannot rationally become the objects of our love, unless they first become the objects of our knowledge. The same course of study, properly directed, will lead us to the knowledge of both. Indeed, neither of them can be known, because neither of them can exist, without the other. Without liberty, law loses its nature and its name, and becomes oppression. Without law, liberty also loses its nature and its name, and becomes licentiousness. J

We have passed through the Red Sea in safety: we have survived a tedious and dangerous journey through the wilderness: we are now in full and peaceable possession of the promised land: must we, after all, return to the flesh pots of Egypt? Human law must rest its authority ultimately upon the authority of that law which is divine. You can not separate GodÂ's law

In 1967 Colorado and California legalized abortion. By June, 1970, when the State of New York passed the first Abortion on Demand Law (24-week limit), it became the 16th state to allow abortion. Laws in the other 12 states, which included Arkansas, Colorado, Delaware, Georgia, Kansas, Maryland, Mississippi, New Mexico, North Carolina, Oregon, South Carolina and Virginia, were very restrictive, typically allowing abortion only for pregnancies due to assault rape, incest and life of the mother as well as for severe fetal handicap.

The only N.T. writer who mentions the word antichrist(s) is the apostle John.

You will only find the word used in 4 verses in the entire 66 books of the Holy Scriptures.

Here are those four verses:

I John 2:18; I John 2:22; I John 4:3; & II John 1:7

1 John 2:18 Little youths, it is the last hour; and even as ye heard that the antichrist doth come, even now antichrists have become many--whence we know that it is the last hour

Here the apostle uses the plural form, antichrists to inform us that many were present at that time.

Also note that at that time the apostle tells us 'we know it is the last hour'. The apostle wrote this epistle not many years

after the LORD'S life, death & resurrection.

Four verses later John affirms the nature and a characteristic of antichrist.

1 John 2:22 Who is the liar, except he who is denying that Jesus is the Christ? this one is the antichrist who is denying the Father and the Son

Any and all who deny that Jesus is Messiah may justly be called antichrist as John writes, 'this one is the antichrist who is denying the Father and the Son'.

1 John 4:3 And every spirit which does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not from God; and this is the antichrist which you heard is coming, and now is already in the world.

Again John tells us who antichrist(s) is/are 'and now is already in the world'. He also tells us another characteristic of antichrist(s). Antichrist(s) do not confess that Messiah Jesus has come in the flesh (i.e. the teachings of the gnostics known as gnosticism).

2 John 1:7 Because many deceivers went out into the world, those not confessing Jesus Christ to have come in the flesh, this is the deceiver and the antichrist.

John again tells us the exact same thing as he did in 1 John 4:3.

Rev. 13:18 Here is the wisdom! He who is having the understanding, let him count the number of the beast, for the number of a man it is, and its number is six hundred and sixty six.

Here the beast mentioned is a man.

Letters in the Hebrew language had numerical counterparts.

This was a common practice at the time of John's writing and those who had such 'wisdom' and 'understanding' as he mentioned would have figured out the mystery of the 'name' of the beast-man by counting the numerical value of the name of the man who was the emperor in power in their time. John was writing to first-century Christians, warning them of things that were "shortly" to take place. Those John was writing to with 'wisdom' and 'understanding' could discern the number of the Beast and the number of his name. If the Beast was not around at that time, he would have been giving them false information.

To use the word 'Antichrist' for a present-day or future political leader is to take it out of its biblical context.

In Hebrew here are the equivalent numerical values for the letters which would have spelled the name Neron Kesar or as many in our day know him as Nero Caesar:

N=50 R=200 W=6 N=50 Q=100 S=60 R=200 = 666

The believers John wrote to would no doubt know of whom he spoke.

They'd have been familiar with the book of Daniel and recognized the Roman Empire and consequently the Roman Emperor who was the most horrific persecutor of Christians and was even called a 'beast' in his day.

Numerous early Christian writers also connect Nero with the beast of revelation. As well as many through the centuries to our present day.

It is no new trend to hear speculation about who might be the antichrist and what the number 666 means.

A search through history and books of the past ages will surely bear this out.

If the multitudes would do away with their newspaper theology and get their eschatology from the Scriptures such foolish and harmfully unsound erroneous speculations would soon have no place in the biblically informed spiritual mind.

To the christian of the first century Nero was a political antichrist, the Roman emperor who demanded to be worshipped as did King Nebuchadnezzar. When Nero claimed for himself the title Lord, the emperor became for Christians a rival Christ, an antichrist.

"My readers will naturally expect that I should either give a decided preference to some one of the opinions stated above, or produce one of my own; I can do neither, nor can I pretend to explain the book: I do not understand it; and in the things which concern so sublime and awful a subject, I dare not, as my predecessors, indulge in conjectures. I have read elaborate works on the subject, and each seemed right till another was examined. Sons of Perdition

Judas and The Man Of Sin from 2nd Thessalonians

February 8, 2009

Many teachers of end time events have done a great deal of harm by painting the man of sin (the one they call Antichrist) as some kind of monstrous individual who leaves in his wake a path of destruction. They make it seem as though it will be easy to spot him. If it were so then the vast majority of peoples would not accept him. They would no doubt run for their lives. Let's take a look at what the Apostle Paul says about him.

2nd Thessalonians 2:

1 ¶ Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together to him, 2 That you be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand.

3 ¶ Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; 4 Who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sits in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God. 5 Do you not remember, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? 6 And now you know what withholds that he might be revealed in his time. 7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now lets will let, until he be taken out of the way. 8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: 9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: 12 That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. 13 ¶ But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God has from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: 14 Where to he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. 15 Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which you have been taught, whether by word, or our letter. 16 ¶ Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which has loved us, and has given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, 17 Comfort your hearts, and establish you in every good word and work.

While reading my bible one day I began to understand something that I have always wondered about. How could somebody who walked with Jesus and ministered in his name, cast out devils and healed the sick, betray him? I began to get the picture awhile back (years) but understand a little better today...

Mark 14:

1 ¶ After two days was the feast of the Passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put him to death.

2 But they said, Not on the feast day, lest there be an uproar of the people.

3 And being in Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured it on his head.

4 And there were some that had indignation within themselves, and said, Why was this waste of the ointment made?

5 For it might have been sold for more than three hundred pence, and have been given to the poor. And they murmured against her.

6 And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble you her? she has wrought a good work on me.

7 For you have the poor with you always, and whensoever you will you may do them good: but me you have not always.

8 She has done what she could: she is come aforehand to anoint my body to the burying.

9 Verily I say to you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she has done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her.

10 And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went to the chief priests, to betray him to them.

11 And when they heard it, they were glad, and promised to give him money. And he sought how he might conveniently betray him.

He was offended at the "waste" and the rebuke of Jesus. He betrayed him because Christ corrected his wrong attitude. I have seen this attitude among believers and I have to say that I believe it is very dangerous. Revenge seems to be Judas's motive and for this he was possessed by Satan himself.

Remember that Judas was called the son of perdition. The man of sin found in 2nd Thessalonians is also called the son of perdition, they will likely share some of the same traits. Here is that portion of scripture which speaks about the man of sin, the one most call the Antichrist.

We must be careful, as Christ said Watch and pray...

Matthew 26:2 You know that after two days is the feast of the Passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be crucified.

Matthew 26:14 ¶ Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests,

Matthew 26:15 And said to them, What will you give me, and I will deliver him to you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.

Matthew 26:16 And from that time he sought opportunity to betray him.

Psalms 55:12 For it was not an enemy that reproached me; then I could have born it: neither was it he that hated me that did magnify himself against me; then I would have hid myself from him:

Psalms 55:13 But it was you, a man my equal, my guide, and my acquaintance.

Psalms 55:14 We took sweet counsel together, and walked to the house of God in company.

John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?

John 6:71 He spoke of Judas Iscariot the son of Simon: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve.

John 13:21 When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say to you, that one of you shall betray me.

Psalms 41:9 Yes, my own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, has lifted up his heel against me.

Luke 22:21 ¶ But, behold, the hand of him that betrays me is with me on the table.

John 13:18 ¶ I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eats bread with me has lifted up his heel against me.

John 13:26 Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon. {sop: or, morsel}

John 13:27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus to him, what you do, do quickly.

John 13:28 Now no man at the table knew for what intent he spoke this to him.

Psalms 109:1 ¶ (To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.) Hold not your peace, O God of my praise;

Psalms 109:2 for the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a lying tongue.

Psalms 109:3 They compassed me about also with words of hatred; and fought against me without a cause.

Psalms 109:4 For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself to prayer.

Psalms 109:5 And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my love.

Psalms 109:6 ¶ Set thou a wicked man over him: and let Satan stand at his right hand.

Psalms 109:7 When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin.

Psalms 109:8 Let his days be few; and let another take his office.

Psalms 109:9 Let his children be fatherless, and his wife a widow.

Psalms 109:10 Let his children be continually vagabonds, and beg: let them seek their bread also out of their desolate places.

Psalms 109:11 Let the extortioner catch all that he has; and let the strangers spoil his labor.

Psalms 109:12 Let there be none to extend mercy to him: neither let there be any to favor his fatherless children.

Psalms 109:13 Let his posterity be cut off; and in the generation following let their name be blotted out.

Psalms 109:14 Let the iniquity of his fathers be remembered with YAHWEH; and let not the sin of his mother be blotted out.

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Psalm 109:15 Let them be before YAHWEH continually, that he may cut off the memory of them from the earth.

Psalm 109:16 Because that he remembered not to show mercy, but persecuted the poor and needy man, that he might even slay the broken in heart.

Psalm 109:17 As he loved cursing, so let it come to him: as he delighted not in blessing, so let it be far from him.

Psalm 109:18 As he clothed himself with cursing like as with his garment, so let it come into his bowels like water, and like oil into his bones.

Psalm 109:19 Let it be to him as the garment which covers him, and for a girdle with which he is girded continually.

Psalm 109:20 Let this be the reward of my adversaries from YAHWEH, and of them that speak evil against my soul.

Psalm 109:21 **Â¶** But do for me, YAHWEH my Lord, for your name's sake: because your mercy is good, deliver me.

Psalm 109:22 For I am poor and needy, and my heart is wounded within me.

Psalm 109:23 I am gone like the shadow when it declines: I am tossed up and down as the locust.

Psalm 109:24 My knees are weak through fasting; and my flesh fails of fatness.

Psalm 109:25 I became also a reproach to them: when they looked upon me they shook their heads.

Psalm 109:26 Help me, O YAHWEH my God: O save me according to your mercy:

Psalm 109:27 That they may know that this is your hand; that you, YAHWEH, have done it.

Psalm 109:28 Let them curse, but you bless: when they arise, let them be ashamed; but let your servant rejoice.

Psalm 109:29 Let my adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle.

Psalm 109:30 I will greatly praise YAHWEH with my mouth; yes, I will praise him among the multitude.

Psalm 109:31 For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save him from those that condemn his soul.

You see Christ had his Judas and so shall we have oursÂ...

The Man of Sin

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; in as much that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

Mark 13:22 For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall show signs and wonders, to seduce, if it were possible, even the elect.

Notice the words "if it were possible, even the elect"

Matthew 7:

21 **Â¶** Not every one that says to me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of my Father which is in heaven.

22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in your name? and in your name have cast out devils? and in your name done many wonderful works?

23 And then will I profess to them, I never knew you: depart from me, you that work iniquity.

24 Therefore whoever hears these sayings of mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

26 And every one that hears these sayings of mine, and does them not, shall be likened to a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:

29 For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

You know them by their fruits brothers. It's a hard word but who can argue against the King?

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"the man of sin" will likely call himself a Christian and be widely accepted as such. He will certainly show no or little regard to God's law. Remember he is also known as "the son of destruction" (perdition). As was Judas Iscariot. What do the a

ancient prophecies say about Judas? "He was my close companion my fellow etc. and he lifted up his heel against me. (the serpent's seed in genesis). Because he loved not mercy... etc. These are the traits we watch for.

The Law of Yahweh

Those who have the spirit of Christ will have the works of Christ.

If we have the spirit of Christ and "walk in it" then we fulfill the law of God. The spirit of Christ will by no means draw us away from it. When Jesus was teaching on the mount of olives, what he taught was well beyond the written law. We are not justified by the law but if you break the law you will lose salvation. What about murder, adultery etc? Can we do these things and retain our salvation? Certainly not. Jesus did not annul the law but he fulfilled it. If you are in him then you will also fulfill the law, by your new nature, the nature of Christ.

JeremYah 31:

31 Behold, the days come, says Yahweh, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they broke, although I was a husband to them, says Yahweh:

33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, says Yahweh, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know Yahweh: for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says Yahweh: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

The law of Yahweh is written on our hearts so it is not burdensome to us, It becomes our nature!

1st John 5:

1 ¶ Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loves the father loves the son.

2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.

5 Who is he that overcomes the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

We are not talking about laws concerning the cleansing / purification etc. as these laws have to do with forgiveness and reconciliation. Christ has accomplished all of these for us, we have been reconciled to God and our Brethren. "by his stripes we are healed"

John 13:34-35

34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

35 By this will all men know that you are my disciples, if you have love one for another.

1st John 3:14-19

14 We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brothers. He that does not love his brother remains in death.

15 Whoever hates his brother is a murderer: and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.

16 By this we perceive the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.

17 But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother has need, and shuts up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwells the love of God in him?

18 My little children let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in works and in truth.

19 And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before him.

The great commandment is to love Yahweh our God with all our heart, soul and strength. The second is to love your neighbor as yourself. and the rest is gravy.

Galatians 5:16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Romans 8:

- 1 ¶ There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.
- 3 For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:
- 4 That the righteousness of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.
- 5 For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit.
- 6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace.
- 7 Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.
- 8 So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.
- 9 But you are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his.
- 10 ¶ And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.
- 11 But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that remains in you.
- 12 Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.
- 13 For if you live after the flesh, you shall die: but if you through the Spirit do put to death the works of the body, you shall live.
- 14 For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.
- 15 For you have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but you have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.
- 16 The Spirit itself bears witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

Like Judas the Son of Perdition will be one who is called but not chosen

We are the Called, the Chosen, the Elect

No man needs to say much concerning the election, chosen, predestination etc. God is very clear in his word concerning these things. Though some clarification may be necessary due to the multitude of false teachings which have been taught for probably centuries.

The question is , What does God say about it?

Acts 13:48 And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Romans 8:29 ¶ For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Romans 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

Romans 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

Romans 8:33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifies.

Romans 9:11 (For the children being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calls;)

Romans 9:12 It was said to her, The elder shall serve the younger.

Romans 9:13 As it is written, Jacob have I loved, but Esau have I hated.

Romans 9:14 ¶ What shall we say then? Is there unrighteousness with God? God forbid.

Romans 9:15 For he says to Moses, I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion.

Romans 9:16 So then it (salvation) is not of him that wills, nor of him that runs, but of God that shows mercy.

Romans 9:17 For the scripture says to Pharaoh, Even for this same purpose have I raised you up, that I might show my power in you, and that my name might be declared throughout all the earth.

Romans 9:18 Therefore has he mercy on whom he will have mercy, and whom he will he hardens.

Romans 9:19 You will say then to me, Why does he yet find fault? For who has resisted his will?

Matthew 24:22 And except those days should be shortened, there should no flesh be saved: but for the elect's sake those days shall be shortened.

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; inasmuch that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

Matthew 24:31 And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

Mark 13:20 And except that the Lord had shortened those days, no flesh should be saved: but for the elect's sake, whom he has chosen, he has shortened the days.

Mark 13:22 For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall show signs and wonders, to seduce, if it were possible, even the elect.

Mark 13:27 And then shall he send his angels, and shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from the uttermost part of the earth to the uttermost part of heaven.

Luke 18:7 And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night to him, though he bear long with them?

Colossians 3:12 Put on therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, bowels of mercies, kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness, longsuffering;

1 Timothy 5:21 I charge thee before God, and the Lord Jesus Christ, and the elect angels, that you observe these things without preferring one before another, doing nothing by partiality.

2 Timothy 2:10 Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory.

Titus 1:1 Paul, a servant of God, and an apostle of Jesus Christ, according to the faith of God's elect, and the acknowledging of the truth which is after godliness;

1 Peter 1:2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, to obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace to you, and peace, be multiplied.

1 Peter 2:6 Wherefore also it is contained in the scripture, Behold, I lay in Zion a chief corner stone, elect, precious: and he that believes on him shall not be confounded.

It is obvious that we can be lost even though we are called but he is not willing that we should be lost. Many of the called will fall away from Christ in their hearts and this will be the great falling away. Jesus said "will the son of man find faith when he comes?"

I also hold to that point of view though I know not everyone sees it that way.
(http://www.beastfromtheeast.org/legs_of_iron.html) Some believe the iron part of the image not to be the Roman Empire, but the Arab-Muslim empire of the 2nd Century. According to some, the Roman Empire didn't fulfill Daniel 2:40, which says the iron must "break in pieces and crush" all the preceding 3 kingdoms. Rome was never able to conquer all the land areas of the three prior kingdoms. The Arab-Muslim empire, however, did succeed in this, as they conquered the areas of Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece and other parts of Europe, the Middle East, etc. Thus the feet part of the image will not be a "Revived Roman Empire" but a revived Islamic empire.

But either way, if the iron part of the Daniel 2 image really is Rome, we must remember that the Roman Empire didn't just conquer Europe--more than half of the empire was in the Middle-East and Northern Africa. This leaves ample room for an antichrist from a Revived Roman Empire to come from the Middle East.

Sons of Perdition
Judas and The Man Of Sin from 2nd Thessalonians

February 8, 2009

Many teachers of end time events have done a great deal of harm by painting the man of sin (the one they call Antichrist) as some kind of monstrous individual who leaves in his wake a path of destruction. They make it seem as though it will be easy to spot him. If it were so then the vast majority of peoples would not accept him. They would no doubt run for their lives. Let's take a look at what the Apostle Paul says about him.

2nd Thessalonians 2:

1 ¶ Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together to him, 2 That you be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as that the day of Christ is at hand. 3 ¶ Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and that man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition; 4 Who opposes and exalts himself above all that is called God, or that is worshipped; so that he as God sits in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God. 5 Do you not remember, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things? 6 And now you know what withholds that he might be revealed in his time. 7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now lets will let, until he be taken out of the way. 8 And the man shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall destroy with the brightness of his coming: 9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders, 10 And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in the men that perish; because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved. 11 And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: 12 That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness. 13 ¶ But we are bound to give thanks always to God for you, brethren beloved of the Lord, because God has from the beginning chosen you to salvation through sanctification of the Spirit and belief of the truth: 14 Where to he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. 15 Therefore, brethren, stand fast, and hold the traditions which you have been taught, whether by word, or our letter. 16 ¶ Now our Lord Jesus Christ himself, and God, even our Father, which has loved us, and has given us everlasting consolation and good hope through grace, 17 Comfort your hearts, and establish you in every good word and work.

While reading my bible one day I began to understand something that I have always wondered about. How could somebody who walked with Jesus and ministered in his name, cast out devils and healed the sick, betray him? I began to get the picture awhile back (years) but understand a little better today...

Mark 14:

1 ¶ After two days was the feast of the Passover, and of unleavened bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put him to death. 2 But they said, Not on the feast day, lest there be an uproar of the people. 3 And being in Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured it on his head. 4 And there were some that had indignation within themselves, and said, Why was this waste of the ointment made? 5 For it might have been sold for more than three hundred pence, and have been given to the poor. And they murmured against her. 6 And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble you her? she has wrought a good work on me. 7 For you have the poor with you always, and whensoever you will you may do them good: but me you have not always. 8 She has done what she could: she is come aforehand to anoint my body to the burying. 9 Verily I say to you, Whosoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she has done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her. 10 And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went to the chief priests, to betray him to them. 11 And when they heard it, they were glad, and promised to give him money. And he sought how he might conveniently betray him.

He was offended at the "waste" and the rebuke of Jesus. He betrayed him because Christ corrected his wrong attitude. I have seen this attitude among believers and I have to say that I believe it is very dangerous. Revenge seems to be Judas's motive and for this he was possessed by Satan himself.

Remember that Judas was called the son of perdition. The man of sin found in 2nd Thessalonians is also called the son of perdition, they will likely share some of the same traits. Here is that portion of scripture which speaks about the man of sin, the one most call the Antichrist.

We must be careful, as Christ said Watch and pray...

Matthew 26:2 You know that after two days is the feast of the Passover, and the Son of man is betrayed to be crucified.

Matthew 26:14 ¶ Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went to the chief priests,

Matthew 26:15 And said to them, What will you give me, and I will deliver him to you? And they covenanted with him for thirty pieces of silver.

Matthew 26:16 And from that time he sought opportunity to betray him.

Psalms 55:12 For it was not an enemy that reproached me; then I could have born it: neither was it he that hated me that did magnify himself against me; then I would have hid myself from him:

Psalms 55:13 But it was you, a man my equal, my guide, and my acquaintance.

Psalms 55:14 We took sweet counsel together, and walked to the house of God in company.

John 6:70 Jesus answered them, Have not I chosen you twelve, and one of you is a devil?

John 6:71 He spoke of Judas Iscariot the son of Simon: for he it was that should betray him, being one of the twelve.

John 13:21 When Jesus had thus said, he was troubled in spirit, and testified, and said, Verily, verily, I say to you, that one of you shall betray me.

Psalms 41:9 Yes, my own familiar friend, in whom I trusted, which did eat of my bread, has lifted up his heel against me.

Luke 22:21 ¶ But, behold, the hand of him that betrays me is with me on the table.

John 13:18 ¶ I speak not of you all: I know whom I have chosen: but that the scripture may be fulfilled, He that eats bread with me has lifted up his heel against me.

John 13:26 Jesus answered, He it is, to whom I shall give a sop, when I have dipped it. And when he had dipped the sop, he gave it to Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon. {sop: or, morsel}

John 13:27 And after the sop Satan entered into him. Then said Jesus to him, what you do, do quickly.

John 13:28 Now no man at the table knew for what intent he spoke this to him.

Psalms 109:1 ¶ (To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David.) Hold not your peace, O God of my praise;

Psalms 109:2 for the mouth of the wicked and the mouth of the deceitful are opened against me: they have spoken against me with a lying tongue.

Psalms 109:3 They compassed me about also with words of hatred; and fought against me without a cause.

Psalms 109:4 For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself to prayer.

Psalms 109:5 And they have rewarded me evil for good, and hatred for my love.

Psalms 109:6 ¶ Set thou a wicked man over him: and let Satan stand at his right hand.

Psalms 109:7 When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin.

Psalms 109:8 Let his days be few; and let another take his office.

Psalms 109:9 Let his children be fatherless, and his wife a widow.

Psalms 109:10 Let his children be continually vagabonds, and beg: let them seek their bread also out of their desolate places.

Psalms 109:11 Let the extortioner catch all that he has; and let the strangers spoil his labor.

Psalms 109:12 Let there be none to extend mercy to him: neither let there be any to favor his fatherless children.

Psalms 109:13 Let his posterity be cut off; and in the generation following let their name be blotted out.

Psalms 109:14 Let the iniquity of his fathers be remembered with YAHWEH; and let not the sin of his mother be blotted out.

Psalms 109:15 Let them be before YAHWEH continually, that he may cut off the memory of them from the earth.

Psalms 109:16 Because that he remembered not to show mercy, but persecuted the poor and needy man, that he might even slay the broken in heart.

Psalms 109:17 As he loved cursing, so let it come to him: as he delighted not in blessing, so let it be far from him.

Psalms 109:18 As he clothed himself with cursing like as with his garment, so let it come into his bowels like water, and like oil into his bones.

Psalms 109:19 Let it be to him as the garment which covers him, and for a girdle with which he is girded continually.

Psalms 109:20 Let this be the reward of my adversaries from YAHWEH, and of them that speak evil against my soul.

Psalms 109:21 ¶ But do for me, YAHWEH my Lord, for your name's sake: because your mercy is good, deliver me.

Psalms 109:22 For I am poor and needy, and my heart is wounded within me.

Psalms 109:23 I am gone like the shadow when it declines: I am tossed up and down as the locust.

Psalms 109:24 My knees are weak through fasting; and my flesh fails of fatness.

Psalms 109:25 I became also a reproach to them: when they looked upon me they shook their heads.

Psalms 109:26 Help me, O YAHWEH my God: O save me according to your mercy:

Psalms 109:27 That they may know that this is your hand; that you, YAHWEH, have done it.

Psalms 109:28 Let them curse, but you bless: when they arise, let them be ashamed; but let your servant rejoice.

Psalms 109:29 Let my adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle.

Psalms 109:30 I will greatly praise YAHWEH with my mouth; yes, I will praise him among the multitude.

Psalms 109:31 For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save him from those that condemn his soul.

You see Christ had his Judas and so shall we have ours...

The Man of Sin

Matthew 24:24 For there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders; in as much that, if it were possible, they shall deceive the very elect.

Mark 13:22 For false Christs and false prophets shall rise, and shall show signs and wonders, to seduce, if it were possible, even the elect.

Notice the words "if it were possible, even the elect"

Matthew 7:

21 ¶ Not every one that says to me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that does the will of my Father which is in heaven.

22 Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in your name? and in your name have cast out devils? and in your name done many wonderful works?

23 And then will I profess to them, I never knew you: depart from me, you that work iniquity.

24 Therefore whoever hears these sayings of mine, and does them, I will liken him to a wise man, which built his house upon a rock:

25 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not: for it was founded upon a rock.

26 And every one that hears these sayings of mine, and does them not, shall be likened to a foolish man, which built his house upon the sand:

27 And the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell: and great was the fall of it.

28 And it came to pass, when Jesus had ended these sayings, the people were astonished at his doctrine:

29 For he taught them as one having authority, and not as the scribes.

You know them by their fruits brothers. It's a hard word but who can argue against the King?

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"the man of sin" will likely call himself a Christian and be widely accepted as such. He will certainly show no or little regard to God's law. Remember he is also known as "the son of destruction" (perdition). As was Judas Iscariot. What do the ancient prophecies say about Judas? "He was my close companion my fellow etc. and he lifted up his heel against me. (the serpent's seed in genesis). Because he loved not mercy... etc. These are the traits we watch for.

The Law of Yahweh

Those who have the spirit of Christ will have the works of Christ.

If we have the spirit of Christ and "walk in it" then we fulfill the law of God. The spirit of Christ will by no means draw us away from it. When Jesus was teaching on the mount of olives, what he taught was well beyond the written law. We are not justified by the law but if you break the law you will lose salvation. What about murder, adultery etc? Can we do these things and retain our salvation? Certainly not. Jesus did not annul the law but he fulfilled it. If you are in him then you will also fulfill the law, by your new nature, the nature of Christ.

JeremYah 31:

31 Behold, the days come, says Yahweh, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah:

32 Not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt; which my covenant they broke, although I was a husband to them, says Yahweh:

33 But this shall be the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel; After those days, says Yahweh, I will put my law in their inward parts, and write it in their hearts; and will be their God, and they shall be my people.

34 And they shall teach no more every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know Yahweh: for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says Yahweh: for I will forgive their iniquity, and I will remember their sin no more.

The law of Yahweh is written on our hearts so it is not burdensome to us, It becomes our nature!

1st John 5:

1 ¶ Whoever believes that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loves the father loves the son.

2 By this we know that we love the children of God, when we love God, and keep his commandments.

3 For this is the love of God, that we keep his commandments: and his commandments are not grievous.

4 For whatever is born of God overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.

5 Who is he that overcomes the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?

We are not talking about laws concerning the cleansing / purification etc. as these laws have to do with forgiveness and reconciliation. Christ has accomplished all of these for us, we have been reconciled to God and our Brethren. "by his stripes we are healed"

John 13:34-35

34 A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

35 By this will all men know that you are my disciples, if you have love one for another.

1st John 3:14-19

14 We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brothers. He that does not love his brother remains in death.

15 Whoever hates his brother is a murderer: and you know that no murderer has eternal life abiding in him.

16 By this we perceive the love of God, because he laid down his life for us: and we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers.

17 But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother has need, and shuts up his bowels of compassion from him, how dwells the love of God in him?

18 My little children let us not love in word, neither in tongue; but in works and in truth.

19 And hereby we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before him.

The great commandment is to love Yahweh our God with all our heart, soul and strength. The second is to love your neighbor as yourself. and the rest is gravy.

Galatians 5:16 This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

Romans 8:

1 ¶ There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death.

15 For you have not received the spirit of bondage again to fear; but you have received the Spirit of adoption, whereby we cry, Abba, Father.

16 The Spirit itself bears witness with our spirit, that we are the children of God:

Like Judas the Son of Perdition will be one who is called but not chosen

We are the Called, the Chosen, the Elect

No man needs to say much concerning the election, chosen, predestination etc. God is very clear in his word concerning these things. Though some clarification may be necessary due to the multitude of false teachings which have been taught for probably centuries.

The question is , What does God say about it?

Acts 13:48 And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.

Romans 8:28 And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

Romans 8:29 ¶For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

Romans 8:30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

Romans 8:31 What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

Romans 8:33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifies.

Romans 9:11 (For the children being not yet born, neither having done any good or evil, that the purpose of God according to election might stand, not of works, but of him that calls;)

Romans 9:12 It was said to her, The elder shall serve the younger.

(1.) Heb. Jehovah, has been rendered in the English Bible Lord, printed in small capitals. This is the proper name of the God of the Hebrews. The form "Jehovah" is retained only in Exo_6:3; Psa_83:18; Isa_12:2; Isa_26:4, both in the Authorized and the Revised Version.

(2.) Heb. 'adon, means one possessed of absolute control. It denotes a master, as of slaves (Gen_24:14, Gen_24:27), or a ruler of his subjects (Gen_45:8), or a husband, as lord of his wife (Gen_18:12). The old plural form of this Hebrew word is 'adonai. From a superstitious reverence for the name "Jehovah," the Jews, in reading their Scriptures, whenever that name occurred, always pronounced it 'Adonai.

(3.) Greek kurios, a supreme master, etc. In the LXX. this is invariably used for "Jehovah" and "Adonai."

(4.) Heb. ba'al, a master, as having domination. This word is applied to human relations, as that of husband, to persons skilled in some art or profession, and to heathen deities. "The men of Shechem," literally "the baals of Shechem" (Jdg_9:2, Jdg_9:3). These were the Israelite inhabitants who had reduced the Canaanites to a condition of vassalage (Jos_16:10; Jos_17:13).

(5.) Heb. seren, applied exclusively to the "lords of the Philistines" (Jdg_3:3). The LXX. render it by satrapies. At this period the Philistines were not, as at a later period (1Sa_21:10), under a kingly government. (See Jos_13:3; 1Sa_6:18.) There were five such lordships, viz., Gath, Ashdod, Gaza, Ashkelon, and Ekron.

If the antichrist / beast was Arab it would mean that he would only disregard the God of his FATHER.. singular. Not plural as the verse in Daniel states. Arabs are of the seed of Abraham, singular. FATHERS is plural and refer to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. Who is the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob? JEHOVAH as stated above aka LORD in the other five verses presented. Scripture defines scripture.

Here is another point regarding the Antichrist being hebrew...

Gen 49:17 Dan shall be a serpent by the way, an adder in the path, that biteth the horse heels, so that his rider shall fall backward. (KJV)

This verse is taken from the prophecies of Jacob to his children in the last days.

Gen 49:1 And Jacob called unto his sons, and said, Gather yourselves together, that I may tell you that which shall befall you in the last days. (KJV)

Note here that Jacob states "which shall befall you in the last days." So Jacob is talking about the days in which we live in, not the days of his children. These are the last days...today.

Well...before anything, it's necessary to understand a few things:

1) The antichrist will not declare himself to be God right off the bat. As I see it in the Scriptures (and as is the prevalent view today), the antichrist will rule for 3 1/2 years. Then, and only then, in what is known by most as the middle of the Tribulation, will the abomination desolation occur (Dan. 9:27;12:11, Mat. 24:15, 2 Thes.2:4), in which the antichrist will "profane" the temple and declare himself to be God.

2) The antichrist will undoubtedly be a man of great power and influence. As I had mentioned before, the Muslims are awaiting the coming of Imam Mhadi, the Islamic redeemer. If the Muslim nations see the coming antichrist as the very personification of their prophesied "redeemer", they will no doubt follow him to the death.

3) The antichrist's dominion will in a large degree be the result of the influence of the false prophet (Rev 13:11-17). Islam is also waiting for the return of Isa, the "Jesus" of the Qu'ran. Isa will show up on the scene with lying signs and wonders and attribute them to the Mhadi.

Something interesting to consider: In Revelation 13:2, the beast is said to have the feet of a bear. In the vision of Daniel 7, the second beast is said to be like a bear; the bear represents the Medo-Persian Empire. I won't get too much into this, but the main thing that is clear from this picture is that the antichrist's kingdom of Rev 13 is founded upon Medo-Persia (which is modern-day Iran). This is really interesting because Syria and Iran are the two main powers of the Middle-East. I don't know if you watch the news much or not, but Syrian president Bashar Al-Assad is often pictured with Iranian president Mahmoud Ahmadinejad.

Notice that Isa is prophesied by Muslims to appear in Damascus (Syria). Another important note is that that Isa will aid the Mhadi in his WARS against a certain "antichrist". Interesting as well in many respects. Most folks believe the reign of the biblical antichrist will be characterized by peace, but all throughout the Bible the opposite is stated--his reign will be characterized by much war.

In addition to a promised redeemer, Islam also believes that an "antichrist" will appear. The Mhadi (real antichrist) will be against Dajjal (a supposed antichrist). And who could Islam's version of the antichrist be? (Assuming there is some truth to this Islamic prophecy, of course) What leader will the Mhadi be fighting against? Who knows...the Pope perhaps...or maybe even an American president?

4) Okay...got a little side-tracked, but back to the point I was trying to make. The last thing we need to consider is that, for those who have believed in the antichrist and in the lying signs and wonders of the false prophet:

"...God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.
(2 Thes. 2:11-12)

Thus, given the aforementioned reasons--that the antichrist's declaring himself to be God will not be immediate, that he will be a man of great authority and influence, that the false prophet's deceitful miracle-working ministry will serve to sway public opinion in his favor, and that the ones who believe in him will be given over to a lie--it would seem more than plausible that Islam would openly embrace this man even after he blasphemes by claiming to be Deity.

Brother, I will be very frank with you. Today, much of the charismatic body of Christ is filled with flesh and pride and error. Any Christian who prophesizes (speaks for the Lord) anything that does not come true (come to pass) is a false prophet. In Leviticus, God tells us that they should be stoned to death.

Deuteronomy 18:18-22

18. I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him. 19. And it shall come to pass, that whosoever will not hearken unto my words which he shall speak in my name, I will require it of him.

20. But the prophet, which shall presume to speak a word in my name, which I have not commanded him to speak, or that shall speak in the name of other gods, even that prophet shall die. 21. And if thou say in thine heart, How shall we know the word which the Lord hath not spoken? 22. When a prophet speaketh in the name of the Lord, if the thing follow not, nor come to pass, that is the thing which the Lord hath not spoken, but the prophet hath spoken it presumptuously: thou shalt not be afraid of him.

Have you or any of your charismatic friends ever uttered a "prophecy" that did not come true? I have heard multitudes of them, starting with the horrors that awaited us following Y2K. Do you remember any of them? Do you remember who the false prophets were? I do!

There are two kinds of false prophets:

1) The first, the lying false prophet, announces events or says things that do not come true. He is obviously a false prophet (Deuteronomy 18:20-22). The penalty in Old Testament times was death for false prophets (18:20). This kind of false prophet

phet is the most easily recognized and least dangerous of the two.

2) The second kind of false prophet is more deceptive (Deuteronomy 13:1-3). He is impeccable in his words at first. An exhortation comes to pass. No fault can be found with his speech. Nevertheless, over time he draws the hearts of the people away from the Lord God Almighty. Finally, he leads them off to serve other gods. This kind of person is very dangerous, indeed the more dangerous of the two.

There are four kinds of False Prophecy:

Most of us are inclined to forget that there are false prophets. However, the frightening facts are these: there are at least two kinds of false prophets and four kinds of false prophecies. The details of these false prophecies are listed in Jeremiah 14:14.

1)**False Visions.** These may come from the evil heart of the false prophet, or they may come from an evil spirit that controls him. The false visions are truly "seen" by the false prophet, but their source is devilish.

2) **Divinations.** This is another form of false prophecy. Diviners may examine the entrails of animals or how rice floats in water. Or they may use a thousand other ways to divine. But their information is finally false even though some things may appear to be true, and entrapment of the simple is made easy. True prophets of God do not read palms or witch water. Joseph Smith is an example of a false prophet who used a "seer stone" for divination.

3)**Idolatries.** This breaking of the first of the Ten Commandments (Exodus 20:3) is the third form of false prophecy. Idols in themselves are nothing, nothing at all (Jeremiah 10:1-5). However, if they are seized by demons, then the idols reflect the power of the demons involved. The Ten Commandments explicitly forbid idols or graven images of any kind. When demons empower the idols, it is not long before prophecies emerge from the demons. We dare not have anything with such demons (1 Corinthians 10:21). Their prophecies are false.

4)**Delusions.** **These are the final kind of false prophecy that I believe is alive and well on this earth today, and especially found in the charismatic movement- delusions of the mind. They are not necessarily from the devil; they may simply be fabricated by the persons themselves. They are still false, however, and very dangerous. And we recall again that false prophets were under severe judgment in the Old Testament. Jeremiah reminds us that even though false prophets prophesy and say all kinds of fascinating things, the Almighty is saying, "I did not send them" (Jeremiah 14:15).**

“The Holy Spirit will lead the believer into all truth”—John 16:13—I do believe this, however we are not like Christ. Christ, even though He was God almighty, laid His Godhead aside, and operated in the power of the Holy Spirit during his incarnation on this earth, but he had the Holy Spirit within him BEYOND (without) measure.

The difference between Christ and Christian believers is that Christ had the Holy Spirit without measure, at all times, while we have the Spirit with measure, at all times, until the rapture, when we will truly be like Him, Then we will have the Holy Spirit without measure as well.

John 3:34

34. For he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him

36. He will honor a god of forces (v. 38). The Hebrew word corresponding to "forces" is ma'uzzim (singular, maoz).

Elsewhere in the Old Testament, the singular form is normally translated "strength." For example,

. . . The joy of the LORD is your strength .

Nehemiah 8:10

. . . The LORD is the strength of my life; . . . Psalm 27:1

Thus, the expression "god of forces" might be rendered "god of strengths." But unlike the more common words for strength, maoz specifically denotes a strong thing or place, such as a rock or a fortress. In the KJV it states, in Daniel 11:38 But in his (place) estate shall he honour the God of forces:... The usual interpretation is that instead of worshiping any supernatural deity, the Antichrist will worship military might. In other words, he will have virtually a religious zeal for accumulating arms and waging warfare. Yet this interpretation cannot possibly be correct, for the same verse goes on to say that the god of fortresses will be one whom the fathers of the Antichrist did not know. No generation and no lineage have been free of men devoted to armament and conquest.

What then is the true identity of the Antichrist's god? The answer depends on recognition that of all men other than Christ who have desired to rule the world, the Antichrist will succeed for a while. The world lies in Satan's control, and thus it must be through Satan's patronage that the Antichrist will rise to the highest pinnacle of power. To secure Satan's favor, he will be obliged to meet the requirement that Christ shunned. Satan told Jesus,

6 . . . All this power will I give thee, and the glory of them: for that is delivered unto me; and to whomsoever I will I give it.

7 If thou therefore wilt worship me, all shall be thine.

8 And Jesus answered and said unto him, Get thee behind me, Satan: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve. (Luke 4:6-8)

It is clear that the title "god of forces" for the sole deity that the Antichrist will recognize and worship must be a veiled reference to none other than Satan.

What exactly are the strong things, the forces, that Satan governs? A recurrent teaching of Scripture, including the Book of Daniel, is that Satan is the head of an organized host of fallen, wicked angels. Elsewhere in Scripture, Satan is given titles similar to "god of forces." He is the "prince of the power of the air" (Eph. 2:2), "a ruler of the darkness of this world" (Eph. 6:12). The title "god of forces" is consistent also with one of Daniel's major themes: namely, the angelic realm. A few verses earlier, in chapter 10, the book reveals that Satan has powerful lieutenants with the rank of prince. Now the view expands to take in other forces who do his bidding.

The text presents an apparent contradiction. The angel presenting the oracle says in one breath that the Antichrist will not honor any god (vs. 36-37), and in the next breath that he will honor a god of forces (v. 38).

Help in reconciling these two assertions comes from the next title used for **Satan. He is called "a strange god" (v. 39). As used here, the term implies a god unrecognized by the principal religions of mankind**—as it says, "a god whom his fathers knew not" (v. 38).

Construing the term in this way clarifies the statement that **the Antichrist will not honor any god**. The statement must be looking only at the traditional pantheon. The view excludes Satan, who, under his own name and in his own person, has never been a general object of worship.

The oracle proceeds to illuminate Satan's role in the regime of the Antichrist, but, unfortunately, the KJV offers a hard to understand translation. The subject of "acknowledge" is not "he," the Antichrist, but the word wrongly translated "whom."

The oracle should read: "And he will do this in the fortresses of forces with an alien god: any who acknowledge him he will greatly honor, and he will make them rule over many, and the land he will divide for a reward."
Daniel 11:39

In the phrase "with an alien god," the preposition is substantially equivalent to the English "with." It can be understood to mean "in the service of," and the whole phrase can be viewed as modifying "forces." Thus, the forces occupying the fortresses where the Antichrist will honor his god will have this same god as their commander.

The oracle reveals that the Antichrist will award wealth and power only to those who are willing to acknowledge Satan. Since the description of the Antichrist's religion precedes the account of his conquests, we infer that his worship of Satan will begin early in his career, before he usurps power over three kingdoms. But whether his alliance with diabolical power will be public knowledge then, we cannot tell. **It is likely that until the world acclaims him as ruler, he will hide his Satanism from all but his closest confederates.**

The Beast of Revelation

Over the years I have heard probably every imaginable, (and some unimaginable), "candidate" for the Beast of Revelation. Everyone from Henry Kissinger to Ronald Wilson Reagan (whose three names each have six letters) has appeared at the top of the "Beast list" at one time or another. Adolf Hitler or Benito Mussolini were popular candidates for the job in the late 1930's and early 40's. Recently, in some circles, Prince Charles has emerged as a contender for the title. Of course, I would be amiss, if I left out William Jefferson Clinton. I have a friend who strongly believed that Gorbachev was the "prophesied one." The mark on his head being a Hebrew "6."

As we approach the end of the millennium, I am sure some interesting books will arise to tell us who the "real" Beast is. Without a doubt these books will make a great deal of money for the authors and the publishers, even though they will be no more Biblical than the National Inquirer is factual. The truly, serious student of the Bible is not interested in speculation based on newspaper headlines, instead of Scriptural exegesis.

Most of us were taught many things that we accepted without truly being "Bereans" (Acts 17:11). We must be willing to examine what we have been taught in the light of the Scriptures. I would encourage you to be a "Berean" concerning what is contained in the following pages.

"Jumping to Conclusions"

Before we turn to the book of the Revelation we must first deal with some false assumptions concerning the Beast. People have often "jumped to conclusions," without Biblical support for their "jumping." We must not "leap" over the lack of Biblical evidence to support our conclusions.

A classic example of "jumping to conclusions" without having Biblical evidence to do so, is the assumption that the Beast of Revelation and the Antichrist are one and the same. Most books on Bible prophecy begin with this foundational assumption. In most instances, the terms are used interchangeably.

My question is "Where is your Biblical evidence to support this conclusion?". There is a "missing link" between the Antichrist and the Beast. What is the Scriptural basis to assume that they are the same person? The Bible describes them in distinctively different ways.

The Antichrist

Antichrist is a term used exclusively in two books of the New Testament: 1 John and 2 John. Contrary to popular assumption the word "antichrist" does not appear in the book of the Revelation; John only uses this term in his first two epistles, with a specific definition.

The term antichrist is used, by John, two ways: it identified a heresy which denied certain essential doctrines concerning Jesus, and it identified a person or persons holding that heretical view.

Concerning the "antichrist heresy," we are told that the spirit of the antichrist denied two basic truths about Jesus of Nazareth. One, that He had not come in the flesh, and secondly, that He was not from God (1 John 4:2-3). Antichrist is described in 1 John 4:1, as a spirit that is working through the false prophets that have gone out into the world. These false prophets teach that Jesus Christ has not come in the flesh. In this they deny the doctrine of the Incarnation (the belief that God became a man).

"Who is the liar but the one who denies that Jesus is the Christ? This is the antichrist, the one who denies the Father and the Son." (1 John 2:22)

An antichrist denied that Jesus was the Christ, the Messiah (Anointed One) prophesied in the Old Testament and anticipated by the Jewish people. In denying this truth about the Son, an antichrist denied the Father as well, because the Father had made His Son Jesus the Christ.

The people who followed this heresy were called "antichrists" (1 John 2:18, 2 John 7). How does John describe these people? They are characterized by four attributes.

First, we see that these antichrists were contemporaries of John who were at work in the first century. John clearly states that the spirit of the antichrist "is already in the world" (1 John 4:3). Those who would have us believe that the antichrist is still yet to come must explain why John was teaching the first century church how to recognize it. In 1 John 2:18, John called his own time "the last hour" because these false prophets had already come, just as Jesus had prophesied (Matt. 24:10-11).

Second, we know that the antichrists had been part of the church.

"They went out from us, but they were not really of us; for if they had been of us, they would have remained with us; but they went out, in order that it might be shown that they were not of us." (1 John 2:19)

The antichrist heresy began with false teachers inside the church, and as such were the devil's instrument to battle the church from within. The antichrists' departure from the church was evidence that they did not truly belong to the church. Even so, they continued trying to lead believers astray (1 John 2:26). This same problem is addressed in John's second epistle.

"For many deceivers have gone out into the world, those who do not acknowledge Jesus Christ as coming in the flesh. This is the deceiver and the antichrist. Watch yourselves, that you might not lose what we have accomplished, but that we may receive a full reward. Anyone who goes too far and does not abide in the teaching of Christ, does not have God; the one who abides in the teaching, he has both the Father and the Son. If anyone comes to you and does not bring this teaching, do not receive him into your house, and do not give him a greeting; for the one who gives him a greeting participates in his evil deeds." (2 John 7-11)

In this we see the third attribute: the antichrists worked by deception. They appeared to be spiritual teachers of truth, but were in reality "wolves in sheep's clothing" (Matt. 7:15, 24:24).

Finally, we can see that the antichrists were recognizable. The discerning believer would be able to examine the teachings of the antichrists and distinguish truth from error. This was John's purpose in writing about them: so that believers of his day could recognize these false teachers by his clear description of them, and avoid them.

The antichrist heresy was apparently an early form of gnosticism, which was a system of belief opposed to orthodox Christianity and prevalent in the second and third centuries. Gnosticism generally taught that matter was evil, that the Incarnation was an illusion, and that salvation was through knowledge.

There were various forms of gnosticism and many Gnostic heretics. Church history records that the arch-heretic of John's day was a man by the name of Cerinthus. Church historian Philip Schaff relates a meeting between John and Cerinthus recorded by Irenaeus:

"On meeting in the public bath at Ephesus the Gnostic heretic Cerinthus, who denied the incarnation of our Lord, John refused to remain under the same roof, lest it might fall."

In 1 John 2:18, John states that "the antichrist is coming" and "many antichrists have come." If John had one particular man in mind as the Antichrist, it is possible that that man was Cerinthus.

The Time of the Revelation

Now, let us turn our attention to the book of the Revelation and in particular, the one referred to as "the Beast."

But, before we can turn to those passages where the Beast is mentioned, we must deal with some basic issues of interpreting the Revelation. It seems that most people today have not read the first verse of this book, which would go along way in helping them interpret it. Take note of verse 1:

"The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show to His bond-servants, the things which must shortly take

place....”

Notice verse 3:

“.... and heed the things which are written in it; for the time is near”

We cannot ignore John’s use of these words, because they supply us with important information to the interpretation of this book. Whereas, most believers are awaiting the events described in the book of the Revelation to find their fulfillment in the future, John clearly tells us that the prophecies of Revelation would begin to come to pass within a very short period of time of his writing. He dogmatically states that the events of Revelation were “shortly” to take place, and that the time is “near.” Both of these words are significant.

The first is the Greek word tachos, translated “shortly”. The Arndt-Gingrich Greek lexicon lists the following meanings under the tachos entry: “speed,” “at once,” “without delay,” “soon,” “in a short time,” “shortly.”

If you look up Revelation 1:1 in any modern translation you will find that the idea clearly exhibited is that of the very near occurrence of the events of Revelation. This term also occurs in Revelation 2:16, 3:11, and 22:6,7,12,20. Even a cursory reading of these verses unavoidably leads to the conclusion that John expected these things to happen “shortly” or “soon.”

The second Greek word is eggus, which is translated as “near” (Rev. 1:3, 22:10). This term literally means “at hand” (John 6:4, 7:2). According to Arndt-Gingrich, when used of temporal relationships it signifies “near” or “soon.” Its importance in our context is clearly that of temporal nearness. The events bracketed by these statements were expected, by the apostle John, to begin taking place at any moment. They were near!

There is a final Greek word that John uses, which also speaks of time. The Greek word mello, which means “about to” (Rev. 1:19, 3:10) emphasizes John’s anticipation of the soon occurrence of his prophecy. When found in both the verb forms appearing in Revelation 1:19 and 3:10, this term means “be on the point of, be about to.” A number of Bible translations confuse the matter when they translate the word properly in Revelation 3:10 but improperly in Revelation 1:19. According to Young’s Literal Translation of the Bible, Revelation 1:19 reads: “Write the things that thou hast seen, and the things that are, and the things that are about to come after these things.” The leading interlinear versions of the New Testament concur.

John, with the use of these Greek words, clearly reveals that the events of Revelation would see their fulfillment in the first century. Therefore, the Beast of Revelation was a contemporary of John, rather than a political figure of the 20th century.

I will seek to properly lay out the evidence as to the identity of the Beast.

The Beast

“And I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having ten horns and seven heads, and on his horns were ten diadems, and on his heads were blasphemous names.” (Rev.13:1)

Most commentators agree that the imagery of the Beast shifts between what is called “generic” and “specific.” Generically, the Beast represents a kingdom. In some passages the Beast has seven heads, which we are told represent seven kings (Rev. 17:10). In other passages the term is used specifically to refer to an individual, one of the heads. For example, John instructs his readers to “calculate the number of the beast, for the number is that of a man” (Rev. 13:18). Most often when people speak of the Beast they are making specific reference to an individual.

In the first verse of Revelation 13, the Beast has ten horns with ten diadems, or crowns. He also has seven heads, which Revelation 17:9 tells us are “seven mountains.” Most New Testament scholars recognize that the seven mountains represent the famous seven hills of Rome. The seven hills of Rome are mentioned in the writings of antiquity, both Christian and pagan. The ten horns, with the crowns, are in reference to the ten empirical provinces of Rome.

In the “generic” sense the Beast is an apocalyptic symbol of the Roman empire. The first century believer was more familiar with the Old Testament than most of us, and would have quickly recognized the similarities between the Beast of

Revelation and the visions of Daniel. In Daniel, we find four beasts representing four kingdoms (Dan. 7:17). These four kingdoms are parallel to the four levels of Nebuchadnezzar's statue in Daniel 2, which represented the empires of Babylon, Medo-Persia, Greece, and Rome. Thus, John's readers would have recognized the Beast representing the kingdom ruling in that day.

But the Beast of Revelation can also have a specific identity as a man. Who is the individual that John calls the "Beast"? What clues has he left us to determine his identity?

Identifying the Beast

John has left us with two major "clues" as to the identity of the one he calls, "The Beast." Both of these clues point irrefutably to the same person, not someone who would be born in the 20th century (which would be of no relevance to his intended audience), but to none other than Lucius Domitius Ahenobarbus, better known as, Nero Claudius Caesar. Nero, and Nero alone, matches the specific expression of the Beast. This diabolical character meets the criteria laid down by the book of the Revelation itself.

The first "clue" for us to examine is Revelation 13:18, which says:

"Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast, for the number is that of a man; and his number is six hundred and sixty-six."

Let us remember that John is writing from the isle of Patmos, where he has been imprisoned. This letter would have been, in all likelihood, carried off the island by Roman soldiers. John had to send his message in "code" lest his captors understand his reference to the emperor. Instead of openly stating who the "Beast" was, he left them a clue that every Hebrew could easily discern.

In ancient times, alphabets served a two-fold purpose. Letters functioned not only as phonetic symbols, but as numerals, as well. The Arabic numeral system, which we use today, was a later development. As a consequence, names had a numerical value. Throughout the ancient world, we find the practice of using the numerical value of a name, as a sort of cryptogram.

The Hebrew spelling of the name Nero Caesar was NRWN QSR (represented here by English letters). The sum of these numbers, which match each Hebrew letter, add up precisely to 666 as follows:

$$N = 50 \quad R = 200 \quad W = 6 \quad N = 50 \quad Q = 100 \quad S = 60 \quad R = 200$$

Is this a coincidence? Or was John sending a message to his readers, which they could have calculated with relative ease?

Another interesting factor to consider is what is called the "textual variant." If you consult a Bible with marginal references you will find something quite intriguing. Regarding Revelation 13:18, your reference may say something to the effect: "Some manuscripts read 616." The fact is that the number 666 in some ancient manuscripts is actually changed to 616. But why? Was it changed by accident or intentionally?

The difference surely is no accident of sight made by an early copyist. The numbers 666 and 616 are not even similar in appearance -- whether spelled out in words or written in numerals. As textual scholars agree, it must be intentional.

A strong case has been made for the following probability. John, a Jew, used a Hebrew spelling of Nero's name in order to arrive at the number 666. But when Revelation began circulating among those less acquainted with Hebrew, a well-meaning copyist who knew the meaning of 666 might have intended to make its deciphering easier by altering it to read 616. It is certainly no mere coincidence that 616 is the numerical value of "Nero Caesar," when spelled in Hebrew by transliterating it from its more widely familiar Latin spelling. Such a conjecture would explain the rationale for the deviation: so that the non-Hebrew mind might more readily discern the identity of the Beast.

The second major "clue" John gives us is found in Revelation 17:9-10, which declares:

"Here is the mind which has wisdom. The seven heads are seven mountains on which the woman sits, and they are se

ven kings; five have fallen, one is, the other has not yet come; and when he comes, he must remain a little while.”

As we stated earlier, the seven mountains represent the seven hills of Rome. But John also tells us that they represent seven kings. Of these seven kings, he tells us five have already fallen. The sixth king is the one, who John says, is now reigning.

Who was this “sixth king”? Flavius Josephus, the Jewish historian of that period, clearly points out that Julius Caesar was the first emperor of Rome and that he was followed in succession by Augustus, Tiberius, Caligula, and Claudius. The sixth was none other than Nero (see Antiquities, books 18 & 19). This is also confirmed by Roman historians, Suetonius (Lives of the Twelve Caesars) and Dio Cassius (Roman History V).

In addition, John states, “the other has not yet come” (the seventh), “and when he comes, he must remain a little while.” Following Nero came Galba, who reigned less than seven months.

Further Evidence

“And it was given to him to make war with the saints and to overcome them....”

(Revelation 13:7)

Nero was not only the sixth emperor of Rome, he was the first to persecute Christians. That persecution began in the middle of November 64 A.D. and continued until June 8, 68 A.D. when Nero committed suicide, a period of 42 months. Take note how this fits with Revelation 13:5, which says:

“And there was given to him a mouth speaking arrogant words and blasphemies; and authority to act for forty-two months was given him.”

Is this just another coincidence, or is it more evidence from Scripture as to the identity of the Beast?

Furthermore, John prophesied the death that the Beast would die. The Beast not only slays by the sword, but ultimately is to die of a sword wound.

Revelation 13:10 tells us:

“If anyone leads into captivity, to captivity he goes; if anyone kills with the sword, with the sword he must be killed.”

The fact that Nero killed by the sword is well documented. Paul, for example, is said to have died under Nero by decapitation with a sword. Tertullian credits “Nero’s cruel sword” as providing the martyr’s blood as seed for the Church. He urges his readers to “Consult your histories; you will there find that Nero was the first who assailed with the imperial sword the Christian sect.”

Likewise, history records that Nero took his own life with the sword. Roman historian Suetonius describes Nero’s death: “Then with the help of his secretary, Epaphroditus, he stabbed himself in the throat.”

It is interesting, from a historical perspective, that Nero was actually referred to as a “beast” by his contemporaries. For instance, the pagan writer Apollinius of Tyana, who lived at the time of Nero, states: “In my travels, which have been wider than ever man yet accomplished, I have seen many wild beasts of Arabia and India; but this beast, that is commonly called a Tyrant, I know not how many heads it has, nor if it be crooked of claw, and armed with horrible fangs.... And of wild beasts you cannot say that they were ever known to eat their own mother, but Nero gorged himself on this diet.”

Nero ruthlessly murdered his parents, his brother, his pregnant wife (whom he kicked to death) and other family members. He was a homosexual, who found sexual gratification in watching torture. He enjoyed dressing up as a wild beast and raping male and female prisoners. He illuminated his garden parties with the bodies of Christians, covered with pitch and set aflame.

Roman historian Tacitus (56-117 A.D.) spoke of Nero’s “cruel nature” that “put to death so many innocent men.” Roman naturalist Pliny the Elder (23-79 A.D.) described Nero as “the destroyer of the human race” and “the poison of the world.” Roman satirist Juvenal (60-140 A.D.) speaks of “Nero’s cruel and bloody tyranny.” Suetonius (70-160 A.D.)

), speaks of Nero's "cruelty of disposition" evidencing itself at an early age. He documents Nero's evil and states: "neither discrimination or moderation in putting to death whosoever he pleased on any pretext whatever."

The Beast Arising from the Dead

"And I saw one of his heads as if it had been slain, and his fatal wound was healed. And the whole earth was amazed and followed after the beast."

(Revelation 13:3)

As we examine this verse and how it relates to the Beast, it is necessary to remember that John's use of the term "Beast" is both specific and generic. Generically, the Beast represents the Roman Empire, while specifically, the Beast represents Caesar Nero.

Understanding the matters we have examined up to this point take us along way toward resolving the interpretive issue before us. The mortal wound to one of the heads is a wound which should have been fatal to the Beast i.e.; Roman Empire. This explains why that after the wound was healed and the Beast continued to live that "the whole earth was amazed and followed after the beast." The seven-headed beast seems indestructible, for the cry goes up:

"Who is like the beast and who is able to wage war with him?"

(Revelation 13:4b)

How does all this imagery apply to Rome and Nero?

At this point we need to examine a significant series of events surrounding the death of Nero. A perfectly reasonable and historical explanation of the "revived" Beast can be found. This is where many interpretations "stumble," they forget the original audience for whom the book was intended and, consequently, overlook the history of the era.

When Nero committed suicide on June 8, 68 A.D., two major inter-related historical situations faced the world. Both carried with them catastrophic consequences.

First, with the death of Nero, the Julian-Claudian line of emperors came to an end. In other words, the blood line which had received worship from the Roman Empire had been cut off forever. To the superstitious, pagan world this was most significant. This was no small matter to the subjects of the Roman Empire.

Second, catastrophe upon catastrophe followed the death of Nero and the extinction of the Roman Empire's founding family. The empire found itself engulfed in civil wars, to the extent that "eternal Rome" was endangered of being reduced to rubble.

Josephus writes concerning these civil wars: "I have omitted to give an exact account of them, because they are well known by all, and they are described by a great number of Greek and Roman authors."

Tacitus writes: "The history on which I am entering is that of a period rich in disasters, terrible with battles, torn by civil struggles, horrible even in peace. Four emperors failed by the sword; there were three civil wars, more foreign wars and often both at the same time.... In Rome there was more awful cruelty.... Besides the manifold misfortunes that befell mankind, there were prodigies in the sky and on the earth, warnings given by thunderbolts, and prophecies of the future, both joyful and gloomy, uncertain and clear. For never was it more fully proved by awful disasters of the Roman people or by indubitable signs that gods care not for our safety, but for our punishment."

Suetonius wrote, concerning the long months following Nero's death, that the empire "for a longtime had been unsettled, and as it were, drifting, through the usurpation and violent death of the three emperors, was at last taken in hand and given stability by the Flavian family."

Titus Flavius Vespasianus restored political stability and established a new dynasty of the Roman Empire. Under the rule of Vespasian the empire was revived and the Beast lived once more.

The relevant verses in Revelation regarding the death and revivification of the Beast are most readily understood as prophesying the earth-shaking historical events after the suicide of Nero in 68 A.D. Rome died, as it were, but returned to life once again.

Conclusion

The view I have espoused here may, in all likelihood, run contrary to what you have been previously taught. My encouragement to you, would be to examine this teaching in light of the Scriptures. Bearing in mind John's original audience (Rev. 1:4,11), his call for their careful consideration (Rev. 1:3; 13:9), and his contemporary expectation (Rev. 1:1, 3).

David Chilton in his book, Days of Vengeance, makes this comment:

"It is significant that all the earliest Christian writers on the Apocalypse, from Irenaeus down to Victorinus of Pettau and Commodian in the fourth, and Andreas in the fifth, and St. Beatus in the eighth century, connect Nero, or some Roman emperor, with the Apocalyptic Beast. There should be no reasonable doubt about this identification. St. John was writing to first-century Christians, warning them of things that were "shortly" to take place. They were engaged in the most crucial battle of history, against the Dragon and the evil Empire which he possessed. The purpose of the Revelation was to comfort the Church with the assurance that God was in control, so that even the awesome might of the Dragon and the Beast would not stand before the armies of Jesus Christ."

How would your view of Christianity change if you came to believe that the Rapture, Tribulation, Antichrist, mark of the beast, Second Coming of Christ, and many other supposedly future events had already taken place?

There is a growing group of Evangelicals who look to the past instead of the future to find fulfillment for many of these prophetic events. This view is commonly known as Preterism, and it produces one of the most extreme forms of Replacement Theology (where the Church replaces Israel), since preterists widely teach that God has divorced Israel and replaced it with the Bride of Christ---the church.

Definition

The term Preterism is based on the Latin preter, which means "past" or "gone by". Preterism teaches that many of the prophecies in the Book of Revelation, the Book of Zechariah, and the Olivet Discourse were fulfilled in the events surrounding the fall of Jerusalem in 70 A.D. Many Preterists actually believe that we are living in some form of the new heavens and the new earth of Revelation 21-22.

Generally, the preterist spectrum can be divided into two categories: partial and full Preterism. Full preterists hold that all Bible prophecy was fulfilled with the destruction of Jerusalem in 70 A.D. If there is a future Second Coming, they say, the Bible does not speak of it. Full preterists also believe there is no future bodily resurrection, which places them outside the realm of historic Christian orthodoxy.

Moderate preterists believe that most, but not all, prophecy was fulfilled in the 70 A.D. destruction of Jerusalem. Although they see many traditional Second Advent passages as fulfilled, they do believe a few passages still teach a future Second Coming (Acts 1:9-11; 1 Cor 15:51-53; 1 Thes 4:16-17). They also see a future judgment and the resurrection of believers at Christ's bodily return.

Advocated

Full Preterism arose in North America during the 1950's and 60's within **Church of Christ circles**. No doubt the American champion of full Preterism has been Max R. King and his son Tim, formerly of the **Parkman Road Church of Christ in Warren, Ohio**. Formerly moderate preterist David Chilton converted to full Preterism several years before his death in 1997. Other full preterists include Ed Steven, Don K. Preston, John Noe, and John L. Bray. An amazingly high proportion of preterist Web sites advocate full a preterist position, even though they likely represent smaller overall numbers than partial preterists.

Partial preterists include a number of well known evangelicals: R.C. Sprould, R.C. Sproul, Jr., Kenneth L. Gentry, Gary DeMar, Greg Bahnsen, Fary North, Hank Hannegraph (The Bible Answer Man?), and Steve Gregg. Many lesser known partial preterists inhabit virtually every community in North America.

Preterists are often found within conservative Reformed circles like the Orthodox Presbyterians (OPC) and the Presbyterian Church of America (PCA). Many people within the home school movement and conservative politically active evangelicals favor Preterism.

Key Passages

The bible verse preterists use most widely in their attempts to establish their thesis concerning Bible prophecy is Matthew 24:34 "Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass, till all these things be fulfilled." (See also Mark 13:30; Luke 21:32)

Kenneth Gentry said of this much debated passage, "This statement of Christ is indisputably clear---and absolutely demanding of a first century fulfillment of the events in the preceding verses, including the Great Tribulation."

However, I believe the timing of "This Generation" is governed by the related phrase **all these things**, which refers to events Christ described in verses 4-31, which are events of the Tribulation. Consequently, Christ was saying that the **generation that "sees all these things" will exist until all the events of the future Tribulation are fulfilled literally.**

Preterists ignore the fact in Matthew 24 that it is Israel whom the Lord is rescuing. Matthew 22-23 speaks of Israel's judgment, which came in 70 A.D., but one should not ignore the identity of the nation rescued in 24:27-31. **It is Israel, so this is clearly a future event. This is a literal interpretation and one that was NOT FULFILLED in the first century.**

Preterists believe they are driven to 70 A.D. fulfillment of Revelation because, like the Olivet Discourse, they believe it says it was to be fulfilled "soon". Thus, they say terms like QUICKLY and AT HAND teach that Revelation had to be fulfilled within a few years of its writing. Even though virtually everyone down through Church History has held to a 95 A.D. date for the writing of Revelation, preterists say the book was written in 65 A.D. The 95 A.D. date renders the preterist view impossible and fortifies the argument that the term quickly and at hand teach imminence—that Christ can return at any moment----not that He will return soon.

I agree, there would have to be a major, fundamental change in the Islamic religion in order for them to accept the antichrist's claim to be God. The Islam of today will not accept anyone who ascribes to himself deity. But, as I attempted to point out in my last post to you, this can easily change given the "right" set of circumstances (i.e. the antichrist would be already in power and loved by the masses, the lying signs and wonders, the strong delusion, etc.).

But then again...the argument you're making, though a reasonable one, starts with an *assumption*--that the religion of the antichrist will be one that is perfectly molded for him, that is, that accepts the deification of human beings.

But who's to say this has to be so? After all, many, if not most, of the major world religions would also officially reject any man that claims to be God Himself. Islam is not alone in this; even Roman Catholicism, with its blasphemous exaltation of the Pope as the "Vicar of Christ", would need a long stretch in their doctrine in order to accept this. The Jews themselves also utterly reject the notion that their Messiah will be God-incarnate.

Hence, almost every religion would need a fundamental change in their theology in order to accept the antichrist's claims to be God. There is no single religion out there that will fit the antichrist to a tee. Not one. And I don't believe we will see one. No, Satan is more crafty than that. His whole method is not to make one dive right into a great sin. He does not produce the Charles Mansons and Adolf Hitlers of the world in a day. Rather, he subtly introduces sin to a person, and makes him slide into it further and further, "smaller" sins leading to "greater" ones, until finally the person has become a depraved monster.

I believe the situation with the antichrist will be no different. Remember that the abomination desolation occurs 3 and a half years into the Tribulation. Rome was never able to conquer the heart of Persia during countless battle against the Parthian and Sassanid Empires.

In Daniel we read:

"And the fourth kingdom shall be as strong as iron, inasmuch as iron breaks in pieces and shatters everything; and like iron that crushes, that kingdom will break in pieces and crush all the others." (Daniel 2:40)

According to this verse the fourth kingdom represented by the iron has to conquer all the other three kingdoms and Rome never did it. The Arab-Muslim Empire on the other not only conquered Babylon, Medo-Persia and the major divisions of the Grecian Empire but it also reached all the way to India in the east and to Spain in the west by 850 AD. Is the Antichrist Jewish?

Is the Antichrist Jewish? Although there is no definitive answer, two Bible verses provide us with good reason to believe he will be. The first appears in the Book of Genesis when God prophesies the coming of Israel's Messiah and Satan's Antichrist.

“ And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.” Genesis 3:15

Later on, when Jacob is blessing his sons, he makes this prophecy about Dan:

“16. Dan shall judge his people, as one of the tribes of Israel. 17. Dan shall be a serpent by the way, an adder in the

path, that biteth the horse heels, so that his rider shall fall backward. Genesis 49:16-17

This reference to a serpent striking a heel may indicate that the Antichrist will be a Jew from the tribe of Dan, but it isn't certain and many reasonable people are divided on this issue.

In addition to this reference to the tribe of Dan, the Book of Daniel points out that the Antichrist will worship himself above all else:

“37. Neither shall he regard the God of his fathers, nor the desire of women, nor regard any god: for he shall magnify himself above all.” Daniel 11:37

This passage is often referenced by those who believe the Antichrist will be of Jewish heritage. **The fact that he will have no regard “for the God of his fathers” is viewed as a reference to the monotheistic God of the Jews.**

Adding further fuel to speculation that the Antichrist might be Jewish is the following passage from the Book of Revelation:

“11. And I beheld another beast coming up out of the earth; and he had two horns like a lamb, and he spake as a dragon.” Revelation 13:11

This verse states that the Antichrist will “come up out of the earth,” a biblical phrase often associated with the promised land and the Jewish people. Throughout the Old Testament, the earth is used as a symbol for Israel, while the sea is used as a symbol for the Gentile peoples:

“1. And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a beast rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads the name of blasphemy.” Revelation 13:1

The verse above is a reference to the Antichrist's kingdom, which as stated before, will be a revived form of the Roman Empire – thus emerging from among the Gentile people. But all the authority of this kingdom will be exercised by “the beast from the earth” referenced in Revelation 13:11:

“And he exerciseth all the power of the first beast before him, and causeth the earth and them which dwell therein to worship the first beast, whose deadly wound was healed.” Revelation 13:12

The first beast, whose “death-wound had been healed,” is the revived Roman Empire. The Book of Daniel clearly states that this world empire will re-emerge in the last days, thus becoming healed of its mortal wound. But the one who rules it will “come up out of the earth.” Could this be a reference to the Antichrist's Jewish heritage?

Will the Jews Accept the Antichrist as Messiah?

All the speculation surrounding the Antichrist's possible Jewish heritage lends itself to another question: Will the Jews accept the Antichrist as their Messiah? Many believe that the following statement by Jesus is really a prophecy that the Jewish people will accept the Antichrist as their Messiah:

“I am come in my Father's name, and ye receive me not: if another shall come in his own name, him ye will receive.” John 5:43

The Antichrist would have to be Jewish in order to be accepted by Israel as the Messiah. Many believe this scripture points to a specific person in the future who will “come in his own name” and be accepted as the Redeemer of Israel.

Conclusion

It is an absolute certainty that the Antichrist will arrive on the world scene as the ruler of a revived Roman empire. However, it is less certain whether or not he will be of actual Italian descent or some other ethnic background. Several scriptures offer the possibility that he could be Assyrian, Greek, or Jewish. But none of them offer us the definitive statement contained in Daniel 9:26.

So how do we rectify these seemingly contradictory prophecies concerning the Antichrist's nationality? Is he Roman? Italian? Jewish? Assyrian? Greek? He doesn't necessarily have to be exclusively one or another. **He could be an Assyrian Jew born and raised in Italy, or any number of possible combinations.** We don't know for certain, but history i

ndicates that each of these prophecies will be harmonized when the Antichrist finally appears.

Two thousand years ago, the seemingly contradictory prophecies of the first coming of the Messiah were all harmonized in the life of Jesus Christ who was a Nazarene born in Bethlehem who came out of Egypt. With the benefit of hindsight, we can see how this was possible, but for the Jewish scholars who lived before the birth and ministry of Jesus, these prophecies were a topic of intense debate. Would the Messiah come from Nazareth, Bethlehem, or Egypt? The answer, of course, was all three.

In similar fashion, a debate continues today in regard to the prophecies of the Antichrist and his national identity. But no matter how much we speculate on the ultimate meaning of the scriptures, we won't know the absolute truth until God's appointed time. As such, it is wise to study these prophecies and teach them to others, so that Christians of the Antichrist's generation will be able to positively identify him based on sound Scriptural evidence.

May the Lord Jesus Christ, upon His Return, find us actively engaged in teaching these truths to others. Until then, live with a patient and enduring faith that His Return is soon upon us.
