FREDERICTON, July 26 / Will God send an Spiritual Awakening? Yes, is the resounding answer from the 30 year old Greg Gordon who is the founder of SermonIndex.net an online digital tape ministry spanning the world. As soon as this message was delivered I knew this was going to spread around the entire world, and it did! This message has been viewed now by over 1 million people across the world."
