So this gives the ability for people to share their burden with the community and at the same time help with the running and expansion of this ministry. I will be building the page where you can reco mmend a file shortly, the amount I am thinking is tentavily \$10USD for a day. Usually if a sermon is featured on the front page for a day it gets between 50-150 downloads in that one day.

Also the featured sermon module appears on many other sites across the web.

I would love to hear any ideas and also feedback. I really feel that its important there is a somewhat of a pulpit on SI, I k now many have commented that they download the files that I feature always.
