To turn to God requires turning from sin. To turn from sin requires turning to God. We need to choose between sin and the Savior because we cannot have both.

To live with God means you cannot live with sin. To live with sin means you cannot live with God. Sin separates us from God, which is why the Apostle John says you cannot know God if you break His commandments.

You cannot love God and love sin at the same time. God and sin are opposites. You will love the one and hate the other.

The defining distinction between sinners and saints is that one hates God and disobeys Him while the other loves Him and obeys Him. Which category we fall into is for us to decide.
