The Secret of Christmas Gifts

I am praying that God will give you a most joyful Christmas in knowing that He rules in the affairs of men and that He is preparing us for our most incredible year!

If you are like me, one of the most difficult things about Christmas is knowing what gifts to get for loved ones. This morning God gave me the perfect answer.

For years I have loved quoting Revelation 5:12 while driving to the office in the morning: "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power, and riches, and wisdom, and strength, and honor, and glory, and blessing."

However, after quoting the verse I have always asked, "How can I give these gifts to Jesus?" He has all power and all wealth. He is the Source of all wisdom, and He has all strength. All honor and glory and blessing belong to Him. He needs nothing from me, and I need all these things from Him.
