From the very beginning it was God's plan that man rule over the earth and everything in it. In Genesis 1:28 God said subdue the earth and have dominion. And how was man to rule, by his words. And not just power is in your words, but authority because as a priest Deuteronomy 21:5 says at the word of the priest shall every controversy and every assault be settled. You have God and his words and the devil and his words, whose words will you establish with your mouth. It's by your words, you have the say so. The devil no longer has rule over you, Jesus took care of that. So, fulfill God's plan and walk in your authority.
