And their spirit was of such that their view of Gods sovereignty had them say to Carey: "The Lord can save the heathen by Himself" He reacted against such a spirit had displayed a missionary zeal that far out weighed many others.

He is known as the fathers of modern day missions but that is a misnomer also. The Moravians which who are chiefly unknown to modern evangelicals were the catalyst of modern missions and Count Zinzendorf himself being the father of this movement.

The moravians sent out more missionaries in first twenty years of their missionary outreaches then the rest of all the churches combined did the past 200 years prior.
