But Jesus gave a command about faith toward Himself, for all Christians to obey.

"And I say unto you my friends, Be not afraid of them that kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do.

But I will forewarn you whom ye shall fear: Fear him, which after he hath killed hath power to cast into hell; yea, I say unto you, Fear him."

It is impossible to have intimacy with God without Loving Him, as it is equally impossible to truly know Him without fearing Him. The faith that denies this, is one that has fell into deception, and likely has received another spirit than the Holy One; I see this as a "Religious Spirit", that justifies men, though separate from the commands in the Word. In this case, God is Love and no judgment, at all; a great lie.

The existence of Hell, as in this scripture above is rooted in the Fear of God as a holy attribute, and through hundreds of references in the Bible, either directly or indirectly, drives the two together as one; "Fear Him who has the power to cast into Hell."; Hell and the fear of the Lord go together.

Often, those who are never born again by the Holy Spirit, cannot reconcile the two, not understanding that the fear of the Lord is clean, converting the soul. A Godly man or woman will always fear the Lord, as they will also believe the Word that Hell is as real, as the Bible states over and over, as it's references to Heaven being our home.

As far as "hypocrisy" would stand, the word means two faced, as the Greek actors would use in theater, to depict sorrow or laughter as they held a different face on a stick to suit the scene.
