What platform are you using? You will need to ensure your computer is connected to the internet when you load the program for the first time because it downloads the 3 MB file of all the sermons. It should automatically load them in, you wil I see a popup saying that it is installing the update, just wait till it says completed and press OK.

While application updates cache, based on the speed of your internet connection it will take time and you would see it being frozen for that time, which is expected.

When you are running App for the first time there is no need to hit "Check for Updates" explicitly as App will do it for you and you should see message "Applying updates" under the menu bar.

Dear brother, at this point you can manually download any text sermon as a pdf by pressing the OPEN AS PDF link at the top of any sermon that is in text. To download the PDF just choose "save target as" on the link or the save button once the PDF has loaded.
