Firstfruits and the Redemption of the Purchased Possession

"But now Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the FIRSTFRUITS of those who have fallen asleep." (my empha sis) (1 Corinthians 15:20)

Christ the FIRSTFRUITS from the dead. The first in a resurrected glorified body.

"Not only that, but we also who have the FIRSTFRUITS of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body." (my emphasis) (Romans 8:23)

We the FIRSTFRUITS of the Spirit. The first to have the indwelling and the sealing of the Holy Spirit of God.

"In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, y ou were SEALED with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is the GUARANTEE of our inheritance until the redemption of the purchased possession, to the praise of His glory." (my emphasis) (Ephesians 1:13-14)

"If in this life only we have hope in Christ, we are of all men most miserable."(1Corinthians 15:19)

The "Redemption of the Purchased possession." This is why our hope in Christ is not in this life only and we are not most miserable.

Our hope is in the Resurrected Christ and His soon coming for us and not in any temporary miserable hope the life in this world presents.

"For the Lord Himself WILL descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of an archangel, and with the trumpet of G od. And the dead in Christ WILL rise first. Then we who are alive and remain SHALL be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air. And thus we SHALL always be with the Lord. Therefore COMFORT one another with these words." (my emphasis)(1Thessalonians 4:16-18) UNTIL HE COMES
