THE TRAP OF a FALSE PROPHET

False prophets are very gifted, but do not bear the fruit of Christ. False prophets flatter a lot, they say all the things you want to hear. False prophets boast in the fact that they do not rebuke. They will deceive you with the message of Love; they will lead you away from the message of repentance. False prophets will lead you away from preparation for the coming King. False Prophets will say peace, peace when there is no peace. DonÂ't be deceived by prophets who preach what you like or want to hear.

GOD's TRUE PROPHETS

GodÂ's true prophets are marked by these three common things "Rebuke, Reprove and Exalt".

They encourage, comfort and edify according to the will of the Lord They will "mourn over sin"; they will carry the burden... GodÂ's prophets should not be able to stand sin... hence the need to "rebuke or reprove"

Yet they are peaceful & merciful.

After a prophet is done releasing the burden, they can almost immediately (within a matter of minutes) put on another spirit (of joy, gentleness and mercy).

They hunger and thirst for righteousness, GodÂ's true Prophets must, at one point or another, preach holiness.

The ProphetÂ's level of purity (sanctity) or the heaviness of the burden laid on him will likely contribute to how the prophet preaches the message of holiness or rebukes sin.

They are marked by persecution because of the message they preach.

They are poor in spirit; after receiving messages and mysteries from God, they must remain humble in spirit.

They have no undivided loyalties (with their master, Jesus Christ).

They bear the Character of God.

THE CRUX OF THEIR MESSAGE will LEAD PEOPLE to RUN TO GOD!!
