TRUTH - a universal language that never changes. Our verbage is only accurate, when we speak TRUTH. What if our c onversation with others, the LORD, and with satan, were ONLY words of TRUTH, and nothing more. Would we only spe ak HIS words, and not out own? How would that change the world around us, our behavior, and that of others?

2+2 = 4. That is TRUTH, that cannot change. It does not depend on our personal opinion, or our use of it. It stands in the solitude of itself. And most of us understand that to think otherwise, would be deviate from this table of TRUTH. And of c ourse, the outcome means that someone somewhere will be short changed. But if we follow the certainty of this simple T RUTH, it can be exchanged with others and used in many wonderful ways to accomplish things we never dreamed possi ble.

Just as CERTAIN as this mathematical TRUTH is, so is the WORD OF HAYAH and HIS SON. And if we carefully apply HIS word, to our life situation at any moment and time, we can be sure of the outcome, without a doubt. Why? Because HIS word is TRUTH.

As we grow in our knowledge of mathematics, we understand that it seems to get more and more complex. But the realit y is that Algebra and Calculus are complex equations of simple TRUTHS, just like our 2 + 2 above. The more complex th e equation, the more care we must take to be sure that we follow the equation precisely, TRUTHFULLY. One deviation f rom TRUTH and the outcome is flawed, and totally inaccurate. We present a deception, rather than TRUTH.

An accountant who keeps ledgers of financial activity within a business, is only worth his/her salt, if they are 100% accur ate. They are 100% accurate, when they do not err in their accounting. They are rewarded for their accuracy in their labo r.

Now let me show you something, if I may.

Mat_18:24 And when he had begun to reckon, one was brought unto him, which owed him ten thousand talents.

This word "reckon". What does it mean?

RECKON - to conclude after calculation

The conclusion is only accurate, if the calculation is accurate. The calculation can only be accurate, if the mathematics is applied correctly. Applied correctly means the outcome is TRUTH. TRUTH THAT NEVER CHANGES.

And so when we see this word "reckon" in scripture, it is referring to a certainty as accurate and TRUTHful, as properly a pplied mathematics. And because it is TRUTH, it cannot ever change. HIS word properly applied ALWAYS produces the correct conclusion. The outcome is assured, because HE cannot deviate from HIS word. To do so would make HE and HIS word a sure FAILURE, as an accountant who errs not in his intention, but in his calculation.

Rom_6:11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our L ord.

We are as dead to SIN (the nature of Adam, as 2 + 2 = 4 Consequently, we are as alive in holiness and purity, as is our RISEN SAVIOR. It cannot be otherwise! TRUTH never changes. We are DEAD unto SIN, because YESHUA was the LA ST ADAM. When HE was crucified, so was the CURSE of ADAM. And the good news is that when HE died, WE DIED WITH HIM!!!! Our old man DIED WITH HIM. It is a certainty that is unchangeable. It is TRUTH. And the good news is, th at YEHOVAH is the ACCOUNTANT. And HE never makes a mistake. HIS CONCLUSION IS THAT WHEN CHRIST DIE D, WE DIED ALSO. We've been dead for 2,000 years. And so is the adamic nature, the old man. YESHUA put an END TO SIN, BECAUSE THE CURSE OF ADAM DIED WHEN HE DIED. And we DIED WITH HIM. We were IN HIM, when H E died. And equally true, we were in HIM when HE resurrected! HALLELUYAH. It is an UNCHANGEABLE CERTAINTY. TRUTH.

So, if YEHOVAH has done the calculation, and HIS conclusion is that WE DIED WITH HIM, then the 100% judgement w

e deserved was PAID IN FULL 2,000 years ago. For our whole life, and not just up to the present in time. What is there i n this life that is yet to be concluded, when the conclusion was settled 2,000 years ago. If HE paid the DEBT of our entir e life, BEFORE we even lived it, and the conclusion is that the answer for us is no longer DEATH but LIFE EVERLASTI NG. How is it you still feel CONDEMNED? That is, if your FAITH is steadfast in HIS WORD.

When our calculation concludes that we are dead unto SIN and alive unto GOD IN YESHUA HA'MACHIACH (JESUS C HRIST), THEN OUR TRUTH AGREES WITH HIS TRUTH and the conclusion cannot be changed. It is a SETTLED ACC OUNT.

So where does all of this leave us? It leaves us with a compass of accurate direction. Man follows a compass to arrive at a desired destination. He is certain that if HE follows this compass, HE will arrive at the desired destination. Beloved, our COMPASS is YESHUA HA'MACHIACH and HIM CRUCIFIED AND RESURRECTED FROM THE DEAD!!!!!! It is a settle d account!!! And if we RECKON otherwise, we have erred. We walk by sight and not by faith. We walk in our on conclusi ons (religion) instead of HIS!!! HIS is a SETTLED ACCOUNT. RECKON it to be so, because HE did the accounting. GL ORY TO GOD.

I hope someone understands this today. Oh the liberty is here. Such a comfort to account a situation and realize that the conclusion is certain because the accountant did not err, and his conclusion is decidedly IN OUR FAVOR!!!!! I don't kno w what else to say.
