

How to Become A Simulcast Location?

Thank you for your interest to live stream the simulcast event “How Long, O Lord” conference in October 4-6, 2018 in Leona Valley, CA.

We are allowing any 3 types of locations to be listed publically as a simulcast location where people in the surrounding state and city can travel to watch the event live at your building. 1) house church (must be established for 2 years with elders) 2) ministry center (an established ministry with building) 3) local church

Here are the steps to become a simulcast location.

- 1) Ensure you have a high-speed internet connection of at least (300-800kps download)

- 2) You will need a project to display the live internet video in your venue.
- 3) We require each location to air the entire event as listed on the schedule for their timezone. Some sessions are “optional” for certain timezones as the sessions are very late at night as the event is live in the PST timezone.
