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12 How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, F76 son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, wh ich didst weaken the nations! 13 For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my thron e above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north: 14 I will as cend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High. 15 Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to t he sides of the pit. 16 They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the m an that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms; 17 That made the world as a wilderness, and destro yed the cities thereof; that opened F77 not the house of his prisoners?

Lucifer was made to be the chief angel of praise with pipes, Jewels etc see here Ezekiel 28

11 Moreover the word of the LORD came unto me, saying, 12 Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king o f Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in bea uty. 13 Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, F136 top az, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee in the day that thou wast created. 14 Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou ha st walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. 15 Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou u wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.

now we see here that who is being described is not a human king but a cherub which is one of the kinds of angel in heav en. this is describing lucifer before his fall. not sure why he is called the king of tyre here but this is clearly him.
