You cannot turn that off. That is the King James Version (w/ Strong's). What you can do is go to the E-Sword website and download the King James Version without Strong's numbers or any other translation.

Those are Strong's numbers. You can't turn them off. If you want a text that does not have those numbers, you will have to download it from the site. You really won't get the full effect of the software until you download several "add-ons."
