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Ancient Israel, a Lesson to the Church Today...

There are much symbolic similarities between the time that the prophet Jeremiah warned Israel – the people of Judah before her captivity to Babylon and the Church today. The people of Judah received warning after warning, rebuke after rebuke, warning them of the impending disaster.

However, they chose to disobey The Voice of The Lord and as such judgment and chastisement fell on Judah and she was carried away to Babylon into captivity where she spent a period of seventy years.

The people of Judah rejected the message of the Prophet Jeremiah; they rejected the counsel of GodÂ's Word and as s uch were totally given over to the sword of the King of Babylon.

The Lord made sure that He placed exit routes for the people of Judah to escape the impending judgment but repeatedly they refused and were stubborn at heart and very rebellious towards. The Lord God of Heaven and Earth.

Interestingly when Judgment came to the people of Judah as we read in Jeremiah 39, not only was there judgment on the religious establishment but even the political and economical establishments, the very things that the Israelites trusted is what The Lord judged and threw down.

The Book of Jeremiah, a Warning to the Church today...

Today the Church of Jesus Christ, which ironically loves to call itself the "spiritual Israel" is doing just the same thing. The Church has and is committing the exact same sin that The Lord alludes to in Jeremiah 3. The Book of Jeremiah should be a warning to all those who call themselves Christians today. As a matter of fact Jeremiah 3 is an indictment against the Church today for forsaking their personal relationship with Jesus Christ and going after Man.

Looking carefully at Jeremiah 3, The Lord states His case against the people of Judah and today symbolically stating this same case against the Church or those who call themselves by the Name of The Lord — ChristiansÂ...

Jeremiah 3:1-25

- (1) They say, If a man put away his wife, and she go from him, and become another man's, shall he return unto her agai n? shall not that land be greatly polluted? but thou hast played the harlot with many lovers; yet return again to me, saith t he LORD.
- (2) Lift up thine eyes unto the high places, and see where thou hast not been lain with. In the ways hast thou sat for the m, as the Arabian in the wilderness; and thou hast polluted the land with thy whoredoms and with thy wickedness.

The Lord clearly spells out to Israel that they were playing the Harlot. They were in love with other lovers and had forsak en The Lord to whom they were engaged. The church today with exception of a few remnant Christians is too engaged in this type of harlotry. So, what is Harlotry anyway?

H2181 זנה zânâh

A primitive root (highly fed and therefore wanton); to commit adultery (usually of the female, and less often of simple forn iciation, rarely of involuntary ravishment); figuratively to commit idolatry (the Jewish people being regarded as the spous e of Jehovah): - (cause to) commit fornication, X continually, X great, (be an, play the) harlot, (cause to be, play the) who re, (commit, fall to) whoredom, (cause to) go a-whoring, whorish.

We see that from the Hebrew that Harlotry is Â'ZanahÂ' which toÂ...

Commit Adultery

Commit Fornication

Playing the Whore

Commit Whoredom

Interestingly in the English language, the Merrian-Webster Dictionary defines Fornication asÂ...

Fornication

Pronunciation: "for-n&-'kA-sh&n

Function: noun: consensual sexual intercourse between two persons not married to each other

While the same dictionary defines Adultery, Whore, and Prostitute as followsÂ...

Adultery

: voluntary sexual intercourse between a married man and someone other than his wife or between a married woman and someone other than her husband; also : an act of adultery

Whore

- 1 : a woman who engages in sexual acts for money : PROSTITUTE; also : a promiscuous or immoral woman
- 2: a male who engages in sexual acts for money
- 3: a venal or unscrupulous person

Prostitute:

- 1 : to offer indiscriminately for sexual intercourse especially for money
- 2: to devote to corrupt or unworthy purposes: DEBASE

2Th 2:1 Now we beseech you, brethren, by the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and by our gathering together unto him

2Th 2:2 That ye be not soon shaken in mind, or be troubled, neither by spirit, nor by word, nor by letter as from us, as th at the day of Christ is at hand.

2Th 2:3 Let no man deceive you by any means: for that day shall not come, except there come a falling away first, and t hat man of sin be revealed, the son of perdition;

2Th 2:4 Who opposeth and exalteth himself above all that is called God, or that is worshiped; so that he as God sitteth in the temple of God, showing himself that he is God.

2Th 2:5 Remember ye not, that, when I was yet with you, I told you these things?

2Th 2:6 And now ye know what withholdeth that he might be revealed in his time.

2Th 2:7 For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth will let, until he be taken out of the way.

2Th 2:8 And then shall that Wicked be revealed, whom the Lord shall consume with the spirit of his mouth, and shall de stroy with the brightness of his coming:

2Th 2:9 Even him, whose coming is after the working of Satan with all power and signs and lying wonders
