In the case of a commonly known domain name such as google.com, someone else will register goggle.com, or gooole.com, or ggggle.com etc. hoping for misspellings. They then sell advertising space on these pages, if enough traffic is diverted to attract the attention of the original domain they may have to get bought out.

In the case of one web ministry with the address Interchristo.com, another person registered Interchristo.org, and another Interchristo.net, and even Interchristo.com with an H. All of these other domains were to divert traffic away from the main domain, it leads to a lot of confusion. In the case of Interchristo, they were able to obtain all of the other domains through legal means so now they all lead to Interchristo.com.
