Gen 3:22 And God said, `Lo, the man was as one of Us, knowing good and evil now. For fear that he (Adam) send forth his hand and take also of the tree of life to eat and live forever,

:23 God sent him forth from the garden of Eden to serve the ground from which he has been taken;

Adam is now to serve the ground (Gen 3:17-19) from which he has been taken **in contrast of** serving God (Gen 2:15) from whom he was created.

Gen 3:17 And unto Adam he said, Because you have listened unto the voice of your wife, and have eaten of the tree, of which I commanded you, saying, You shall not eat of it: cursed is the ground for your sake; **in the pain of labor** shall you eat of it all the days of your life;

:18 Thorns also and thistles shall it bring forth to you; and you shall eat the plants of the field;

:19 By the sweat of your face shall you eat bread, till you return unto the ground; for out of it were you taken: for dust you are, and unto dust shall you return.

Gen 2:15 And God takes the man, and causes him to **rest** (in serving God) in the garden of Eden, to serve it, and to keep it. (Heb 4:3a, Heb 4:10)
