The Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.)'s highest governing body voted Friday in favor of a proposal that would allow for the o rdination of non-celibate gays and lesbians.

The 218th General Assembly, meeting in San Jose, Calif., this week, voted 380-325 to send the overture \hat{A} - that would delete the requirement that clergy live in "fidelity within the covenant of marriage between and a man and a woman, or c hastity in singleness" \hat{A} - to the denomination's 173 presbyteries for approval.

Adding to the blow to conservatives, the Assembly also adopted a supplementary authoritative interpretation of the PC(USA) constitution that would allow gay and lesbian candidates for ordination to conscientiously object the current "fidelity and chastity" standard and the local ordaining body to discern whether the declared objection is disqualifying. ...
