As one who has experienced revival in his ministry, he speaks with authority and insight on the themes of revival a nd evangelism. The famous Ulster revivalist, the Rev. W. P. Nicholson, said of him, "Through European countries he h as brought thousands to Christ through his teaching and preaching. I have followed his work for many years. He has bee n used of God in mighty revivals in many places. He knows from a long and wide and successful experience what reviva I is, and how to make use of it.
