He even clai ms to have raised dozens of people from the dead.

In one YouTube video, Bentley, who is Canadian, can be seen kneeling in the stomach a man with stage 4 colon cancer. When the man bent over in obvious pain from the blow, Bentley said, "I had to be obedient to the Lord, sir, but I believe t hat colon cancer is coming right out of your body now." In other videos, Bentley explains how he kicked an elderly lady i n the face, banged a crippled woman's legs on a platform ...
