Thanks for your prayers....Jay has been going through a discipleship program with a Christian brother here at camp.

This week however, he visited the Doctor and had devastating news, he may never regain feeling in his foot or walk properly. (He sheared off 6 inches of bone and his ankle was rebuilt with a steel plate). He will be bed ridden for 6 months.
