Hi MaryJane,

You do need accept cookies. The being is that your iPhone, needs the cookie file stored on the device in order to know you are logged in. By accepting a cookie from a site what that means is that site asking your browser, ie Safari on your iPhone, to create a file that includes among other things, the log in information so you don't have to relog in every time.
