IHOP has a long history of embracing unbiblical and wild manifestations, calling it all the Holy Spirit. Such as:

- Touching people and knocking them over en masse in power displays and "impartations" of strange "anointings".
- 2. Wild convulsion like shaking on the floor, rolling around, growling like lions, barking like dogs, etc.
- 3. Anti-Scriptural visions and dreams, third-heaven experiences talking with departed saints, etc.
- 4. The "Jesus as lover" heresies perverted out of the Song of Solomon (and experiences of sexual interactions with this other "jesus" in visions and dreams)
- 5. Constant promotion of angels, and of visions and encounters with angels (without testing the spirits). -Even financial a ngels.
- 6. Gold dust and diamonds falling from the cieling and oil appearing on hands.
- 7. Trance-like worship beating pagan drums and moaning and shaking in such trances.
- 8. An extremely high emphasis on supernatural experiences and miracles without testing the spirits.

- 10. Ear tickling prophecies, many of which have been documented and proven false.

The list could go on. I walked into an IHOP church a number of years ago and immediately discerned perverse spirits in that place. In my post I am referring to the practice of folks, often times posting on the forum here at SI, to judge others without any where near the knowledge or information to do so.

I think we would agree that all things need to be sifted and tested through the grid of God's Word. However, in looking at past threads concerning IHOP, and a couple of posts in this thread, it is apparent that is not what is happening. Many posts are just blanket opinions based on virtually nothing other than assumption, fear, misunderstanding, a lack of Biblic al understanding of the supernatural, or sometimes just plain old jealousy. It appears that many of the "heresy hunters a nd condemnation specialists" do not believe anything happening is from God... unless it is what is happening with them.

I must say it is disheartening to see those who have no miracles, power, or demonstation of the Spirit in their ministries or lives condemning as, "false and deceptive", those who do. Some of you may be surprised, or maybe not:) that for the whole of last year I attended IHOP. I am no longer there but f eel reasonably qualified to give an opinion on this thread. For the most part, I saw nothing different that what one would expect at a Pentecostal church. There was the odd strange person, manifesting noise and attention attracting activity, but for the most part there was simply praising, preaching and prayer. I did not particularly care for the worship, finding it to be soulish, but I could say that about countless churches that I have visited. The preaching, for the main part, was very g ood, especially from Mike Bickle. Lou Engle was the strangest of all the preachers I heard there. I believe that it is their underlying teaching that it the most dangerous. Since the late 80s, Mike and his aquaintences, have considered themselves to be special, prophets for the end of times. They have successfully convinced the mainly younger people that attend the church, that they too are part of a special generation. Its a form of dominionism that they teach. I believe it to be a dangerous teaching, although it is quite subtle.

I also believe that the leadership have zero discernment when it comes to the likes of Todd Bentley and so on. When we consider error in the church at large, we must first consider what the standard is that we compare the fault with the true. In the christian realm, it is always the Bible, the word of God, that is the infallible authority in these realms, and the deeds and fruit that follow.

We must also understand that the nature of deception is always mixture...a counterfeit; a big hunk of truth, mixed in with portions of the lie.

IHOP?

IHOP is that. A neo-monastic order...with many of the accoutrements of the Catholic counterparts...the cloister; the nunnery; the MONASTERY, WITH ALL OF THEIR ERRORS! The super-spiritual society...the cutting edge, the Elijah generation.

- 1. Contemplative prayer. It is pagan in custom and historically. It is the Babylonian counterfeit to true prayer. It is inward, promoting mantra and guided imagery. It teaches to empty the mind, rather than pray by faith through the son of God seated at the right hand of the Father. It is pagan, and faithfully promoted by IHOP. It is a major error.

At IHOP the devotees are constantly flattered as BEING PRAYER MISSIONARRIES"..."FORERUNNERS"...and "FRIENDS OF THE BRIDEGROOM"...and bannered as the "one half of one per-cent" who devote all to Jesus....The super-spiritual few...like Elijah, and John the Baptist. It always promotes "HIGH SPIRITUALITY" and ends in "COLD LOVE", a sall monasteries do. It is bondage, but these kids believe it. - 3. The taking of Oaths. This is forbidden in the bible...and is used to control. It is actually called sacred by the IHOP mandate, and it is a document that you must sign, to be a part of her. Often it is for a period of time..seve ral months, a year, or whatever the requirement for the level that you buy into.
- 4. The selling of the ministry. You must pay IHOP to be there...and more or less, according to the level you attain. Be ginners pay as much as 4500 dollars for a six month program. You must pay for teaching..and certain classes. The "stud ents" are urged to solicit there friends and families and previous local churches for the cash, which in turn is handed ove r to the lhop leaders.

The students are taught the methods of the fund raising missionary. Letters, pleas and speaking trips to get "supporte rs" on board, all for the "prayer missionary" that you have became. Professional beggary.

5. Women in authority over men. This is strictly forbidden in scripture, but yet is common practice at Ihop. There is a permissive attitude that has placed several women as leaders and teachers at IHOP; The "prophetic" especially, along w ith other departments. This has ,in my opinion, brought much confusion, to add into the already chaotic and cold.

In reality, those in peril may indeed be those who will not judge, or discern. The primary standard must be the Word of God, and the doctrine of the apostles derived from it.

There are some fundamental doctrinal errors that have been adapted at Ihop, that have born bad fruit. They are:

- 1. The promoting of mystical and monastic practices, particularly "CONTEMPLATIVE PRAYER", which is not prayer a t all, but a satanic counterfeit that is the same as TRANSCENDENTAL MEDITATION", using guided imagery, singular fo cus, mantras, repetition and the clearing of the mind to attain a spiritual state.
- 2. The monastic practice of continual repetitive prayers and praise...done by rote, or as duty. It is not spirit led, but m an controlled, and no real worship at all.
- 3. The fellowship of others who also promote these errors, such as the Roman Catholic church, and other dividers who do the same.

Every Christian church should be, according to doctrine, teaching, and "de facto"; practice.

I have been reading the back and forth in this thread and thought I would tell a little story of my own experience.

Two years ago my son came apart at the seams. He had been walking away from the Lord while trying to maintain the i mage for parents and others around. We spend our Thanksgiving evening two years ago trying to talk him down from w anting to run away and give up. He had gotten into sin and made some grave mistakes that could have cost him a great deal.

Needing to get away and be in the presence of God, he opted to spend his own money to go to a two week summer ca mp at IHOP. This led him to attend the One-Thing Internship for 6 months the next term. It totally transformed his life. The young man that left the house was broken. The young man that returned was restored and on fire for God in an am azing way.

Yes, they do focus on and equip for winning the lost. In fact, my son was sent out in teams at Halloween to stand in line at spook houses for the purpose of striking up conversation and winning the lost. Very effective. They went weekly to e vangelize.

I have several close friends who attend regularly or are on staff there. IHOP has a very narrow focus, although it has be en expanding in recent years. They are now going to give 50% of their energies to outreach ministry. They have never claimed otherwise. The fruit, however, does remain. My son is now attending another school in Tulsa with a VERY different focus, and is thriving. He has a passion for the Lord that is consistent and fervent.

I don't agree with everything that happens at IHOP, but then again, I don't agree with everything that happens anywhere, including my own life. I am a work in progress.

I would just ask that in examining any ministry we seek to know the truth. I cannot speak for Mike Bickle or the things th at have influenced him. I don't know that. What I do know is my own experience. If there is legitimate error, make sure the facts are straight and approach the subject with humility and in love. Speak the truth, but do so in love. Pray about the situation first. Spend weeks, months, however long it takes before denouncing someone or some ministry.

Let us be clear; this is not about just reading the bible. It is "Meditative Prayer; Contemplating scripture and applying your imagination visually, to attain revelation; even visions.. It is an ancient form of Prayer practiced in Hindi India and throughout the Bhuddist world today; Now! It is called; Guided Imagery."

Well, there is certainly nothing wrong with a creative imagination; it is a gift from God and can enhance every area of our life. When, however, it is elevated and received as a vehicle of revelation from God, and even touted to be one; there is a problem.

Then you enter into the occult world of ancient forms of witchcraft; IE:...the Babylonian Mysteries. There have been hundreds and hundreds of articles written that positively identify these practices as ultimately Satanic. The latest big stir came about with Todd Bentley, in Lakeland Florida, and his so called revival.

Todd became famous as he testified of a diminutive gal-pal angel, Emma, who carried around bags of gold, and the giant "Winds of Change" angel anointing him. He also spoke of visits to the heavenly realm; chats with Jesus and Abraham and Moses, and describes them in great detail.

He also was exposed as an adulterer, thief, and psychopathic liar at the same time... deals with... visualization"

I have copied below a portion of Todd Bentley's article on an "Open Heaven". (found on his web site and in his own word s!) In this article Todd is basically teaching Christians about astral projection.

Bentley states that Å"heaven is without the sickness, the sin, the disease, the death, the poverty, and the devil, that we have here. And since we enjoy what God has created in the earth, then is there any reason why we canÂ't, as spiritual beings with spiritual senses, go places in the spirit and taste, see, and touch everything that God has created in the heavenly dimension? After all, everything we have in the natural/temporal realm is created out of the heavenly invisible realm in the first place!" (Todd Bentley, Open Heavens Part 1 of 2.)

Again, proof that Todd is into many non-biblical new age techniques:

"Friends, I believe there comes a Â"placeÂ" where there is an invitation for each and every one of us to pray for spiritual understanding, for the eyes of our hearts to be opened, and for us to be filled with the spirit of wisdom and revelation. ItÂ's an atmosphere where we can make ourselves available to receive solid teaching and guidelines from GodÂ's word to help us exercise our spiritual senses. Also, itÂ's where we can learn to open and sanctify our imagination, and begin to h ave the eyes of our understanding enlightened (the mindÂ's eye) whereby we begin to touch the dimension of seeing—the dimension of visions, trances, dreams, and angelic visitation"

Todd believes that: "Why? One reason is because the "dimension of seeing" goes hand in hand with the seer anointing, and God wants to give us that anointing. And in Part 2 he writes: "Is there really an invitation to come boldly before the throne? Can I really have trances, visions, dreams, and visitations of the Lord? Be aware of angels? What do you me an, itÂ's my inheritance now?"

And yet again, Todd Bentley takes liberty with the Word of God because there is NO such anointing mentioned in the Ho ly Bible. Unfortunately for him and those that follow him, I fear that many of their experiences will be from the spiritual re alm of the fallen angel kind!

Lastly, he teaches people that they must "sanctify their mind's eye":

Method #2

"Use your imagination to imagine yourself as one of the story characters or as an onlooker"...

"Play out the story in your mind applying all five of your senses."

My comment:

It is an error to ascribe to the imagination the work of the Holy Spirit. To teach that the imagination does the work of the Holy Spirit is an error. To train the imagination to do the work of the Holy Spirit is an error. Is this something that man has to work at?

When believers study (read, hear, reflect on, look into, etc.) the Word of God; the Spirit of God that indwells us points out Truth. Other words people have used for "points out Truth" include: highlights, words jump out to me, convicts, focus es attention on, teaches, etc. As Jesus said, this is one of the roles of the Holy Spirit who indwells us. It is not the role of human imaginations. I doubt that there is a born-again believer, reading this thread, who has not had such a direct exper ience of Truth. In part this is one reason we continue to grow, year after year, reading the same Scripture: "I have read this 20 times and never...."

"Use your imagination to imagine yourself as one of the story characters or as an onlooker": Any believer who has denie d Christ in public does not need to "imagine that they are Peter.", etc., etc., etc., etc. The Holy Spirit applies the Word of G od to us. The only reason I can think of that someone would need their own imagination is if they had no access to the H oly Spirit. P. S.: The Bible is not full of "stories" it is full of Truth, history, fact, real life reality, including Jesus ministering through parables. Those that have ears, hear.

"Play out the story in your mind applying all five of your senses.": Following this \hat{A} "advice \hat{A} " should avoid the understanding, the mind that needs renewing, and plunge you into the flesh (flesh sensations, hearing things, seeing things, tasting things, smelling things). It is the eyes of our understanding that need enlightening (Eph. 1: 18 \hat{A} – 19).

IHOP imaginations will give rise to/beget imaginations. Imaginations are not reality. Worse than that, they lift themselves up AGAINST THE KNOWLEDGE OF GOD. As it has been described on this thread, this really seems to me to be an ex ample of how to counterfeit revelation. As it is described, it could easily result, over time, in a believer no longer being ab le to distinguish between their imagination and hearing from God.

The reason I asked the question is this. Another post appeared that gave the idea that John G. Lake did not believe in the existence of hell. The creed quoted uses the term to mean "universal" as in the world wide body of believers. I wanted to bring back up the obvious violation of scripture at Ihop, and the "de-facto" behavior of the jist of their mini stry. It is monastic in nature, driven bt the Catholic sub-doctrine of justification by works, and devotion. The more devotion and intensity of committment, the better, and the more pleasing to God.

This is the driving and compelling force that chains one to believe that they have become a "PRAYER MISSIONARY FOR GOD!" Young people are recruited, who are able to fulfill these Spartan duties, with the idea that they are part of this High Prophetic Call until Jesus returns. The prayers are in general confined to a set of 10 or 12 "Apostolic" prayers that Mike Bickle has set to follow; within the parameters, so to speak. Different nations, and venues are then addressed in intercession in that manner. These are by no means Spirit led, or generated. They are routine, and disciplined. They are in effect, performances. This is the offering of IHOP. It is patterned after the tabernacle of David; the same as the Catholic monasteries that did the exact same practices,... mimicking.

It is not born of the Spirit of God, as true worship always is.

They are big on fasting coorporately, some speech fasting, and extreme devotion...but it's discipline; not spirit led.

Colossians 2:22-23 (King James Version)

22.

"Which all are to perish with the using;) after the commandments and doctrines of men?

23. Which things have indeed a shew of wisdom in will worship, and humility, and neglecting of the body: not in any ho nour to the satisfying of the flesh."

Here are some of the scripture violated there.

1. Contemplative prayer. It is pagan in custom and historically. It is the Babylonian counterfeit to true prayer. It is inward,

promoting mantra and guided imagery. It teaches to empty the mind, rather than pray by faith through the son of God se ated at the right hand of the Father. It is pagan, and faithfully promoted by IHOP. It is a major error.

- 2. Rote, or repetitive PRAISE, done as exercise, rather than SPIRIT led by faith. Teams do SETS...over and over and overusually 30-40 hours a week. This is deemed as WORSHIP, and it is not. It is aesthetic legalism; a counterfeit to true, free and often spontaneous praise...stemming from the heart, not the will, and a legalistic compulsion.
- ...Much of this stems from the Catholic sub-doctrines of living a sacrificial life...the more you sacrifice the better. ...alway s give more...and the more sacrifice the more pleasing you are to God.
- ...again...experience trumps doctrine..

At IHOP the devotees are constantly flattered as BEING PRAYER MISSIONARRIES"..."FORERUNNERS"...and "FRIEN DS OF THE BRIDEGROOM"...and bannered as the "one half of one per-cent" who devote all to Jesus....The super-spirit ual few...like Elijah, and John the Baptist. It always promotes "HIGH SPIRITUALITY" and ends in "COLD LOVE", as all monasteries do. It is bondage, but these kids believe it. It freezes their spiritual growth in pride; believing they are somet hing they are not.

- 3. The taking of Oaths. This is forbidden in the bible...and is used to control. It is actually called sacred by the IHOP man date, and it is a document that you must sign, to be a part of her. IHOP demands that you swear this oath, with your sign ature. This controls the prayer room, the musicians, and the teams that perform. Often it is for a period of time..several months, a year, or whatever the requirement for the level that you buy into.
- 4. The selling of the ministry. You must pay IHOP to be there...and more or less, according to the level you attain. Begin ners pay as much as 4500 dollars for a six month program. You must pay for teaching..and certain classes. The "student s" are urged to solicit there friends and families and previous local churches for the cash, which in turn is handed over to the lhop leaders.

The students are taught the methods of the fund raising missionary. Letters, pleas and speaking trips to get "supporters" on board, all for the "prayer missionary" that you have became. Professional beggary.

5. Women in authority over men. This is strictly forbidden in scripture, but yet is common practice at Ihop. There is a per missive attitude that has placed several women as leaders and teachers at IHOP; The "prophetic" especially, along with other departments. This has ,in my opinion, brought much confusion, to add into the already chaotic and cold.



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Madame Jean Guyon was a christian mystic that has influenced with her spiritual writtings more evangelical protestants, than any other christian mystic so of the past. I have read about her life story and she has been a great influence on holiness movement and pentecostal/charismatic movements. Joh n Wesley considered Guyon one of the most saintly christians since the apostolic age, even Spurgeon the uncompromised puritan (or the last of the puritans) admired her. She has been a good influence too on the keswick movement (a calvinist version of weslyan holiness movement).

The intresting thing is that she was persecuted by the catholic church for being deeply in love with her Saviour and for neglecting the ritual prayers ect. On the other hand she is considered as heritic by the same orthodox calvinist christians who think Finney was an heretic too.

I mention her because im sure she has been a great influence of the mysticism of the evangelicals today. I see a great difference between those old c hristian mystic saints, so much admired by Tozer and the so called mystical experiences and methods of prayer practices by many evangelicals today.

The difference is not so much in the outward form but in substance. Whatever i have read from those self proclaimed evangelical mystics, it's very shal low and spurious, and the emphasis is not on God and his glory but on technics and methods and the focus is on "Me", how good this makes me feel. There is no sanctifying experience, no death to self, no holy desire that God be glorified with all of my being and life, no rightteouness or holiness unto the Lord. Spiritual discerment is a gift, we our warned to, "Test all things and hold fast to that which is good".

A.B.Simpson said: "The simple things of all these things is the Word of God, and the practical test of righteouness and holiness. Let us be prepared for false spirits and let us not fear to try them, for if God is giving us any message or revelation, He will always give us ample time to be sure that it is of God."

Another thing we need to check is, what kind of fruit is being produced? Whatever we experience does it bring us closer to God and encourages us to be christ-like? Does it intensify our yearning to be filled with the love of God?

Again A.B.Simpson wrote: ".....deep humility, earnestness and soberness and free from extravagance and error...mark deepening of the spiritual life... The Spirit of Pentecost is the spirit of peace and love and holy unity."

Someone said about a counterfeit experience: " You will feel at once that is not of God. It will be harsh and repelling; your spirtual nature will revolt."

I have been for years in the past in the charismatic movement and i know exactly by experience how often evil spirits will come and counterfeit the gen uine to deceive me, and lead me in the wrong path. There is lot of counterfeit and very little of genuine Holy Ghost blessings today in the charismatic ci rcles. Im sure that like me many genuine christians, who have been part of same movement have sensed the evil influences attacking their minds, trying to take hold of their souls.

If you open the door of your heart to such things you will suffer the consequences of spiritual oppression, i dont say you will be possessed by a demon, a true child of God is not "owened by the devil" but those evil influences can damage the sanity of the christians and lead them to spiritual depression.

No, not at all Ginnyrose. There are several programs at Ihop that require fees, pay, for those participating. It is not unlike different Universities that charge fees. The "STUDENT" pays for his "education", in some cases \$800 to \$900 per month PLUS extra for certain classes. Some programs include board, others may not.

There is a full time paid clergy class there that do not pay, but are supported by the organization. There are sets performed by musical bands accompanied with 3-4 singers, and a prayer leader that are on staff. Anyone can pray from the audience without being a paying student or staff member, as long as it is in the parameters of the apostolic model praye rs.

I assume you are referring to my statement;

"They in effect "SELL" the ministry, and charge for the brethren to participate. This is beyond scriptural; it is wrong." I stand by that statement.

The overwhelming majority of those in IHOP must pay to continue to participate; to be full time prayer missionaries. They are taught to sponge off of the family, original churches and the public, and are taught to develop "ministry" letters to solicit steady monthly funds, as they are now on the mission field. They are now Prayer missionaries; the highest calling on Earth. They are taught that this is God providing for them, and of course, full time. You don't work. You are supported.

Because IHOP is essentially a "PRAYER and PRAISE" ministry, in effect, a devotee must "pay to pray". Many, many have left IHOP disillusioned because they couldn't raise the cash.

The holy church of the Lord Jesus never has, nor ever will charge money to receive you . The only pay required has been met by the blood of Jesus. IHOP is a machine now, requiring millions of dollars each year to operate. Mike bickle h as publicly lamented about HOW "expensive" it is.

Everyone, on top of that, is "encouraged" to tithe, and give to the IHOP cause.

The undisciplined, the ghetto poor, the weak minded, the aged infirmed, the working single moms etc. are missing a t IHOP meetings. They are not "trained", have the vast sections of time required, are not disciplined to do so, and are virt ually non-existent. The young and the strong, the elite and willing...and this means youth...malleable; able to be molded, and idealistic are targeted.

The church is not the church if it is not the church of the weakling. The billions and billions of souls on the EARTH must be supported by a grueling 6 or 7 day work week, to survive. Many, that do even this, do not.

The ONE exquisite and perfect vehicle designed by God himself to meet the needs, spiritual and physical, is the LOC AL CHURCH, with all of the blood, sweat and tears, diapers and teenagers, bills and conflicts of marriage and life! The local church where "WHOSOEVER COME! and drink of the fountains of LIFE.....WHOSOEVER!..LEPERS, drunks, junki es, harlots and weaklings. In that community we participate in loving God and each other, and learn to reach out BECAU SE we love to a dying world.

This is the testimony of a former IHOP intern. You may read it, and others concerning IHOP on "THE GOSPEL MASQUERADE"... It is somewhat lengthy, but very relevant, and worth the read.

THIS IS TYPICAL FROM MY EXPERIENCE. THERE ARE HUNDREDS AND HUNDREDS MORE.....

"There were many, many experiences that made me do a double take and say Â"what?Â" while I was at IHOP but th at internal questioning was quickly explained away or rebuked by internship leaders. Once I began to deviate from IHOP Â's teachings and study scripture on my own for answers to the internal conflicts I wrestled with, I began questioning the pseudo reality I had been conditioned to embrace.

Suddenly I saw the isolated red flag incidences as a seamless pattern of error and the veil of deception fell. I stoppe d rationalizing and justifying. Enough was enough and I was done and wanted out.

There are much more personal experiences than I can put into one single blog post, but here are a few I still recall pr etty strongly.

- 1. Mandatory fasts which made me very physically ill. They would never admit to having "mandatory" fasts but wh en you donÂ't have any food available, close down the kitchen, give your cook the day off and donÂ't allow interns to hol d jobs (so that they have money to go buy food if they arenÂ't participating in the fast) then that is called mandatory.
- 2. Being practically held hostage in the prayer room and told that it was required that I be there and I was not allowed to leave even though I did not feel well and wanted to go back to my apartment. I was told I needed to stay in the prayer room to be part of the "corporate anointing" and that I shouldnÂ't leave.

It was one of my "required" prayer room sets as an intern so I spent the remainder of that 2-hour set in one of the side prayer rooms in the back sobbing on the floor because I wanted to leave so badly and our internship leaders were s tanding by the door. You might ask "why didnÂ't you just force your way out and leave anyway?"

When you are part of cult where free, independent thinking is not condoned when you donÂ't comply with what is ex pected of you, very often guilt, manipulation and penalties are instated for those who resist. Interns who didnÂ't follow Â" the rulesÂ" of the internship were penalized through loss of privileges (such as loss of your day off, having to do extra w ork/manual labor, etc.)

3. The grip of control and micro-management increasing: greater demands and restrictions on interns (such as increa

sed pressure to fast more to attain a higher pinnacle of spirituality) being told where we had to sit when in the prayer roo m, taught a model for how to pray, how to dance, sing, etc. Any form of worship outside of this model was not considere d to be acceptable. It had to fit IHOPÂ's style and method to be admissible.

- 4. Mandatory journaling assignments which we had to do weekly and then we had to turn in our journals to be read by internship leaders
- 5. Seeing how controlled the prayer room was. Rather than having freedom to express my heart to the Lord, I was put in a box and told how I had to do everything IHOPÂ's way. I had reading and writing assignments whenever I was in the prayer room.
- 6. There was no alone time ever to really think, reason, test, question or process anything. We were run ragged from sun up to late into the night which always left me exhausted, depleted and burnt out.
- 7. Once when I got sick, my mother came to pick me up and internship leaders resisted letting me leave with her (eve n though she lived in town). My internship Â'com leaderÂ' (short for community leader) objected and still impressed upo n me the importance of going to the prayer room even though I was too sick to get off the couch. My mother said Â'she i s my daughter and IÂ'm taking her home and taking care of her. Period.Â'
- 8. The more leadership responsibility I was given as an intern, the more I got peeks into the "inside". I saw the outter fringes of the internal operations of how IHOP functioned. I was on an IHOP dance team and sang as a chorus leader on a few worship teams. To dance, I had to follow a specific model that IHOP required.

To sing, I had to attend the briefing/de-briefing meetings before and after each worship set where I saw first-hand ho w carefully controlled that the seemingly "spontaneous" aspects of worship were carefully calculated and often planne d ahead of time.

- 9. Another intern got deathly ill and it wasnÂ't until she ended up being hospitalized that internship leaders took serio usly the fact she was sick. They accused her of faking an illness to get out of attending IHOP classes and time in the pra yer room. This was told to me directly by that intern.
- 10. If I wanted to go anywhere off IHOP property (even to go see my family who lived in town) I had to notify internshi p leaders of my whereabouts at all times. I had no autonomy or freedom as an individual. Some leaders who were 19 (b ut were former interns which gave them elite status) were telling me where to be, what to do and when I was expected to be home.

I had to answer to them for everything. I was in my early 20′s and had lived on my own before so the feeling of suffocation and having no personal rights to space, privacy, independent thought, etc. was overwhelming.

There is much more but I think thatÂ's a sufficient start to at least give you an idea of some of what was happening whe n I was at IHOP. It wasnÂ't until after I left that I began to see far more than I had been able to see when I was still involved.

The casual observer on the periphery wonÂ't necessarily see the reality of all that is happening there because they a re seeing the veil that IHOP has built to carefully cloak the truth of a lot of what really happens.

After I left, I realized how worn out and exhausted I was in every way imaginable. I spent days and weeks sleeping a nd physically healing from the trauma of the experiences I had just come out of and to let my body heal from the fasting and sleep deprivation. It took a long time for me to really start healing emotionally and spiritually and to begin putting pie ces together.

Recovering from mental and spiritual abuse like that is a hard road and a difficult place to come out from. I did month s of research after I left IHOP and the immediate dust had settled. I wanted to see the roots of the giant beanstalk that h ad sprouted up and choked the life out of everything in me.

I started going back as far into the history of IHOP as I could. As interns we were required to listen to 18 hours of au

dio CDs recapping all of the history of IHOP and the "prophesies" that led to itÂ's starting. I started researching on the internet about the names of the so called prophets of this movement and what they had come out of. That led me to pick ing apart a very carefully woven web of key players that all were connected to this massive organization.

I shared with one parent who e-mailed me about her own child at IHOP the importance of praying that the L-rd will o pen their eyes not only to see, but to recognize and identify the red flags of IHOP. The thing is, they are probably alread y seeing them, but rationalizing and excusing them away as isolated events rather than viewing them as a destructive pattern.

I pray that the Father will show those there who are truly seeking him the pattern of red flagsÂ...making them so obvious they can no longer ignore them.

My hope is that the young people there who are much like I was will begin to question what they see and compare it with what the scripture actually saysÂ...not how Mike Bickle twists and teaches itÂ...and that they have the courage to i dentify it and reject it.

!!!!!! Those who oppose IHOP and speak out typically experience some kind of consequences or backlash. People ar e a commodity there. They are traded. When wounded ones leave, IHOP leadership doesnÂ't sweat over itÂ...new and unsuspecting people who are ignorant of their dangerous devices but are hungry for emotionally-driven experiences and spiritual highs will come back in the same door the others left. ItÂ's a revolving door of deception. !!!!!!

The deceptions of IHOP are treacherous and very real. Did G-d use that place in my life and work together for my good the devastation I experienced? Absolutely. But that is a testimony to the goodness of our G-dÂ...not a stamp of approval on a place. Remember he spoke through a donkey and a burning bush. That doesnÂ't mean we should glorify donkeys and start worshiping bushes.

IÂ've been asked many times how my eyes were opened to see what was happening at IHOP and how I got out, etc . IÂ've thought about that many times and the simplest answer I can give is that I knew who my source was. G-d was my source of instruction, teaching, counsel, truth, etc. It was His voice I was seeking to hear and His approval I desired. IHO P wasnÂ't my source. So when the things I heard from the L-rd through prayer and studying His word were in conflict wit h the things I was being taught in IHOP it made the decision to leave an easier one.

It was traumatic and painful and IÂ'm not going to minimize that. But it was the price of protecting truth and I knew th at staying would have compromised what I knew was right and since my desire is to delight the heart of my Father, once He removed the scales, I was out.

My desire is to see people set free to live lives of healing and wholenessÂ...walking in genuine love and pursuing tru th. My prayer is that the things you read on this blog inspire you to that end.

I don't personally know this intern you posted...but I do know several other folks that have come through the internship p rogram at IHOP and they are all flatly denying this quote as accurate.

I also understand that a disciplined lifestyle is not an easy lifestyle. It sounds as if this is probably the first personal discipline this person had encountered.

Just as an example lets take her first point...

"1. Mandatory fasts which made me very physically ill".

So they have mandatory fasts...big deal! If you will not discipline yourself to a full fast two days a week you do not have t he personal discipline required to be a minister of Christ. Now, before you get all bent out of shape at me realize those w ere not my standards to start with. Those were the standards put down by John Wesley. He would not have allowed her to be in ministry either. In fact if we go to the earliest Christian documents we will find a similar expectation expressed in the Didache. She wouldn't have cut it there as well.

Almost all of the complaints listed are simply someone whining about being given structure and discipline. So IHOP requires fasting, prayer, journaling, etc.,good for them! So IHOP has folks that watch over that development and read the journaling to insure that the interns are actually gaining the discipline to be effective ministers... and the fault with that is W HAT?

If any of this seems to severe I would suggest that you do a reread, analysis, and evaluation of the actual contents and c ontexts in which 2 Timothy was written. You will find Paul tells Timothy to get his discipline and toughness in order. In cr ude modern, but very accurate language, Paul told Timothy to quit feeling sorry for himself, suck it up, and get his head back into the game! Especially take note of chapter 2.

I also think it is fair to say in view of Paul's treatment of Mark, after he quit and went home to mom as well, that Paul wou ld tell this girl not only good bye but to also not come back until her thinking was straight! That was how Paul handled it.

"Dear sad parent, I was 45 years old when I took a trimester at IHOP in '03 by the grace of God He led me and my wife away from that movement but it took about a year for me to realize it was a cult, and two years for me to see the whole prophetic, Apostolic, signs and wonders thing for what it is, DECEPTION.

I know exactly what you are saying about contemplative prayer being like T.M.

But it doesnÂ't stop there, there is so much new age and Catholic mysticism mixed into the pot that it is one big hodge-podge of ecclesiastical witches brew.

In a prophetic class that was taught by Kirk Bennett one of our assignments was to take a scripture and repeat it over and over for two hours straight, praying it, repeating it until we got a revelation, this is nothing but a mantra, repetitious prayer, something we are not supposed to be part of.

At the time I thought something was wrong with me because I never got anything (but tired) unless it was by my imagination, but later I was pleased to know that I was being protected, thatÂ's why it wasnÂ't working. Many errors have been exposed in regards to IHOP and Mike Bickle over the years and many people have come out from among them. Many others continue to follow in error and delusion. It is quite a confusing "swirl" when one is involved.

Yes, many young people are hungry for more of the presence of the Lord and desire to be wholehearted and the message Mike teaches really convinces one that doing the "one thing" as he defines it, praying 24/7 and fasting is the way to know the Lord in a deeper experiential way. These two biblical disciplines are emphasized to a extreme degree.

He is very charismatic and uses "loaded language" that grips the emotions, his vision for himself and his house of prayer is very grandiose. Like the Cults he also teaches his followers what kind questions they will most likely encounter by those on the outside and prepares them with "loaded phrases" that stunt real deep thinking, questioning and discernment.

A common response a IHOP-er would give to someone questioning what they are involved in is, "Burning hearts make dull hearts uncomfortable." The point being that THEY have the burning heart and YOU do not because you are questioning their teaching and practices which seem to contradict the Scriptures.

He believes God is changing the understanding of Christianity through his ministry in one generation. I find that quite astonishing actually, that Mike is the one who is chosen for such an exalted task. Where do you find this in Scripture? He is the one who tells of his experience in Cairo Egypt where he alleges he heard the "audible voice of God" who told him this.

I find it curious and wonder, "Did he test that spirit? Did he test that message? He tells many fantastic stories such a s this that seemingly always somehow exalt HIM, HIS calling and HIS ministry. Dreams, prophesies and "encounters", angelic and otherwise are sought after and emphasized. It is an unreal, hyper-spiritual counter culture.

Everything revolves around the house of prayer and Mike, and no one wants to "miss anything". He has an amazi ng way to create a swirl of excitement. There are many spirits at work there.

I believe he draws people after himself and his grandiose vision all the while telling everyone, "It is what the Holy Sp irit is doing at the end of the age." He teaches the young adults they are going to be end-time "apostles" who will rel ease the judgments of the Lord through prayer.

There is great elitism and selfish ambition at work. People circle around Mike and vie for his attention. Most of the fo undational "blueprint" prophesies for Mike and IHOP came from Bob Jones and Paul Cain.

His ministry requires the time, finances and life of his followers. Many have signed a pledge called the Â"Sacred Trus tÂ". There is a Â"devouringÂ" aspect to his ministry.

If you measure the teachings of Mike Bickle against the plumbline of Scripture in context you will know where the erro r is.

I am writing from experience, I was part of it for some time. Mike Bickle does have some good teachings but there is a lot of mixture as well. The emphasis "appears" to be on a individual relationship with Jesus BUT the structure demands 8-10 hours a day in the prayer house plus administration hours all the while "raising" ones own support and when that doesnÂ't work finding gainful employment.

Many live at poverty level, go into debt because they cannot raise support, use welfare and stand in lines to get food. But they keep getting taught about "supernatural provision" and there are always lots of "glory stories" but not too many of the "gory stories " are told from the platform.

Mike teaches his followers to live a Â"fasted lifestyle.Â"

I observed in myself and those around me, that we were not using critical thinking skills and examining everything we we re being taught like we are told to by the Lord Jesus and writers of the NT.

As far as all the giving to the "poor" they say they are doing I would suggest you examine the financial statements (if there are any) before you just believe what Mike and his staff are telling you. In the past Mike has not wanted to be ac countable to a true board, he has stated he wanted to run the finances of his ministry like Benny Hinn does.

He tends to surround himself with Â"yesÂ" people, those he can easily control. Most people who tried to bring accountability didnÂ't last too long as that is not what Mike wanted.

Will people hear? If they are willing and have a love of truth, they will.
