WASHINGTON - The Food and Drug Administration on Wednesday approved an implantable computer chip that can pa ss a patientÂ's medical details to doctors, speeding care.

VeriChips, radio frequency microchips the size of a grain of rice, have already been used to identify wayward pets and li vestock. And nearly 200 people working in MexicoÂ's attorney generalÂ's office have been implanted with chips to acce ss secure areas containing sensitive documents.

Delray Beach, Fla.-based Applied Digital Solutions in July asked the FDA for approval to use the implantable chip for me dical uses in the United States. The agency had 60 days to reply to the "de novo" application.

ItA's the first time the FDA has approved the use of the device, though in Mexico, more than 1,000 scannable chips hav e been implanted in patients. The chipA's serial number pulls up the patientsA' blood type and other medical information

With the pinch of a syringe, the microchip is inserted under the skin in a procedure that takes less than 20 minutes and I eaves no stitches.

Silently and invisibly, the dormant chip stores a code — similar to the identifying UPC code on products sold in retail st ores — that releases patient-specific information when a scanner passes over the chip.

At the doctorA's office those codes stamped onto chips, once scanned, would reveal such information as a patientA's all ergies and prior treatments.

This is good wisdom. Although I will not be taking a mark any place in order that I might buy or sell. Again, like you menti on, the prophesy hits this too close to just explain it away. We have been forseeing this day and it is near upon us-shall we now reinterpret the passages and take a mark that we have been watching for?

The greatest fear I have is that those who have placed ALL their eggs in the pretrib basket will take the mark because the Rapture has not taken place. For the sake of history there has never been a time that I am aware of or have ever hear d of when this passage of scripture concerning an etch in the right hand or forehead could have been fulfilled. We can sepiritualize the text, but the passage has all the indicators of a literal hermeneutic. And when the plain sense makes good sense we should seek no other sense. "VeriChip is very simple. A glass capsule about the size of a grain of rice, the VeriChip contains only a basic microchip p rogrammed with a 16-digit ID number and an antenna. When the VeriChip is hit with radio waves from a scanner, the chip responds by broadcasting its ID number. There are no batteries in the VeriChip, and it works for a lifetime.

The only way to get meaningful information with the VeriChip, which will initially cost about \$150 for the human version, is by linking the ID number to a computer database. That database might give a dog's name and home address at an animal shelter, or show a history of adverse drug reactions in an unconscious human in a hospital emergency room.

Of course, a VeriChip implanted for medical reasons could be used in other ways, such as tracking movement in a building through scanners built into doorways. Applied Digital is interested in expanding to non-medical uses, including credit-card verification and security. In July, the attorney general of Mexico said he and 160 of his top officials had received VeriChip injections for gaining access to top-secret offices.

As I said, I'm willing to get a VeriChip if the product adds to my personal safety and convenience. But I also want to kno w up front that implanted ID chips won't send us down a slippery slope to a Big Brother society where our every move is monitored."
