My pastor delivered a powerful sermon entitled "Wasting Away in our Sin" on Thursday night. He talked about ten excuses for failing to repent from sin and refuted the excuses in the Word.

Here are the ten excuses and I've included them all in the first person:

- 1. I don't know how to repent (or it could be stated I can't repent).
- 2. I don't have time to repent.
- 3. I just have a sinful nature.
- 4. I'm just waiting on Jesus to repent.
- 5. I can't repent because of my circumstances.
- 6. I can't repent because my health is poor.
- 7. I can't repent because I have a hard heart.
- 8. I just didn't know any better (i.e. ignorance).
- 9. It's God's responsibility to make me repent and if I haven't repented it's His fault.
- 10. I don't need to repent.

One of the scriptures, he closed the sermon with was Psalms 106:43 which says " Many times he delivered them, but th ey were bent on rebellion and they wasted away in their sin." This is what happens when we fail to repent or make excu ses for not repenting.

Let's not waste away in our sin any longer.

Mark 1:15 .. "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel."

What does it really mean to REPENT??? Strong's Greek Word 3340 means

- 1. to change one's mind, i.e. to repent
- 2. to change one's mind for better, heartily to amend with abhorrence of one's past sins

This word 3340 (Metanoeo) is from two other Greek words 3326 (Meta) which means "with, after, behind" and Strong's Greek word 3539 (Noeo) which means "to perceive with the mind, to understand, to have understanding" or "to think upon, heed, ponder, consider"

Paul told us that God would have to grant repentance (2 Timothy 2:25) to us, but Jesus told us that we must REPENT and BELIEVE. That is because there are TWO parts to us repenting. The first part is us CHOOSING by our own wills to BELIEVE ONLY what God says. To do that we have "to think upon, heed, ponder, consider" ONLY what God says. We can be "sorry" for our sins, but that is only the first step.

2 Corinthians 7:10

For the sorrow that is according to the will of God produces a repentance without regret, leading to salvation, but the sorrow of the world produces death.

If we are just "sorrowful" for our sins without BELIEVING that God has set us free IT WILL ONLY PRODUCE DEATH. We should all want the LIFE of JESUS and we can ONLY get that if we BELIEVE that He has set us free at the Cross.

2 Corinthians 7:8-13

- 8 For though I caused you sorrow by my letter, I do not regret it; though I did regret it--for I see that that letter caused you sorrow, though only for a while—
- 9 I now rejoice, not that you were made sorrowful, but that you were made sorrowful to the point of repentance; for you were made sorrowful according to the will of God, so that you might not suffer loss in anything through us.

2 Timothy 2:20-26

- 20 Now in a large house there are not only gold and silver vessels, but also vessels of wood and of earthenware, and some to honor and some to dishonor.
- 21 Therefore, if anyone cleanses himself from these things, he will be a vessel for honor, sanctified, useful to the Master, prepared for every good work.
- 23 But refuse foolish and ignorant speculations , knowing that they produce quarrels
