Israel is not in any current bible prophecies, only the Church is which is made up of FIRST the Jew, then the Gentiles. There is no separate agenda for the Jews and one for the gentiles. They are now one in Christ.

This is a covenant that was made to Abraham, which by the way was a gentile, there was no such a people called the Jews at this time because Judah had not yet been born.

Snuf: You have a valid point here. Dan. 9:27 does not specifically say that the anti-christ will make a peace treaty with Israel. It is a "best guess" interpretation. Who knows but what they might be right, and who knows but what they might be wrong.

But I must agree with my brothers here that to write Israel out of Bible prophecy by replacing them with the church makes mincemeat out of scripture. Scripture plainly speaks of three distinct groups in prophetic writing. Israel, the Nations, and the Church. The fact that all three are addressed specifically demonstrates that all three play a distinct role and that clear demarcation is made between the three. We have not gone from three to two by a mere reassignment of existing prophecy. Take, for instance, the statement of Israel's being grafted back into the olive tree. She was the original tree, we as gentile believers were grafted to that root, and the original branches will one day be grafted back in. Israel is not rejected any more than I am. It is God's desire that Israel be saved, and one day they will come to Christ just as I did. Granted not every one who is of Israel by blood will be saved just as not every gentile is saved.

Don't worry about staying on or leaving the site. You can be born again and not have all of your eschatological ducks in a row. I would encourage you though to look carefully at what fruit has been borne historically by the root of replacement theology. It's just a huge stretch even to try to pull that sort of a theology out of the Bible.

On a personal note, I don't totally agree with the majority of the modern American church world's eschatology either. I contend there is no special rapture, that the day of the Lord is the day of the Lord. I also don't think God has a date marked on a calendar that He has simply not shared with Jesus yet. There are simply too many scriptures that say that we can actually hasten the day of the Lord, that that day is tied to the fullness of the Gentiles coming in.

God Bless you snuf. Don't just read and study one point of view on this thing and follow their particular scripture trail. Get in the word and dig.

Let people of shrewd intelligence calculate the number of the Wild Beast; for it indicates a certain man, and his number is 666.

As Scripture indicates,

the mark = the name of the beast reckoned up by wise calculation.

This person's name calculated by numbers = 666

The first century readers of John's letter, to whom it was addressed knew full well what to do with John's words here. They did what was the common practice of the day and added up the numeric equivalent of the Hebrew letters of the name of the emperor Nero Caesar. Documented archaeological finds show that a first century Hebrew spelling of Nero's name = 666. The letters Nrwn Qsr or neron qsr.

Apollinius of Tyana, a contemporary of Nero wrote this of Nero,

"In my travels, which have been wider than ever man yet accomplished, I have seen many, many wild beasts of Arabia and India; but this beast, that is commonly called a Tyrant, I know not how many heads it has, nor if it be crooked of claw, and armed with horrible fangs. . . . And of wild beasts you cannot say that they were ever known to eat their own mother, but Nero has gorged himself on this diet."

The beast of Revelation has been identified long ago.

There's no double-fulfillment of prophecy.

May we not ask about another as did John Baptist,

Luke 7:20 And having come to Him, the men said, John the Baptist sent us to You, saying, Are You the One coming, or should we expect another?

RE: Daniel 9:27 Then he will be master of a covenant with many for one seven: At half of the seven, he will cause to cease the sacrifice and the approach present; on a wing of the sanctuary shall be desolating abominations. Till the conclusion of the era the decided conclusion will be poured forth on the desolation."

One poster wrote of their confused understanding of this in these words,
