Being challenged to answer questions about what we teach or preach can be an excellent opportunity to explain or unfol d things that otherwise might have gone unmentioned. And the right question, even if it is asked by an enemy to you or f rom the most hostile mind or angry mouth, can be like a sweet pitch of a baseball that a slugger with a bat knocks out of the park.

Men that are challenged whom God upholds can shine in the face of criticisim.

But just as criticism can cause the questioned to stand out even brighter and to bring forth truths that they otherwise might not have, it can also reveal the nature of the critic.

If the critic has no intention but to prove others wrong, or to antagonise them into mispeaking so that they can hold up th eir error to ridicule, or if they have come at their targets with only one acceptable answer in mind, if they will only have th em to repeat word for word what it is they themselves believe and that only will be acceptable, then the moment of critici sm that the critic has long sought for will be their time, not to shine, but to glow with a foul and insidous odor of ignomy a nd contempt.
