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It would be interesting to try to define the "time of the end". Here are some interesting scriptures.

Act 2:16-21

- (16) But this is that which was spoken by the prophet Joel;
- (17) And it shall come to pass in the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh: and your sons and your daughters shall prophesy, and your young men shall see visions, and your old men shall dream dreams:
- (18) And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:
- (19) And I will shew wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke:
- (20) The sun shall be turned into darkness, and the moon into blood, before that great and notable day of the Lord come:
- (21) And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

Joel prophesied that the day of pentecost would be in the last days. John was given the vision and wrote it as revelation after the day of pentecost a good many years. So if the day of pentecost is "in the last days" then surely the revelation given to John is also "in the last days." Peter stands up and states that this event is part of Joel's prophecy and then repeats the entire prophecy. Part of it was fulfilled at pentecost and beyond perpetually until the last part of it is also fulfilled.
