Ezekiel 33

Renewal of EzekielÂ's Call as Watchman

1 The word of the LORD came to me: 2 Â"Son of man, speak to your people and say to them: Â'When I bring the sword against a land, and the people of the land choose one of their men and make him their watchman, 3 and he sees the sword coming against the land and blows the trumpet to warn the people, 4 then if anyone hears the trumpet but does not heed the warning and the sword comes and takes their life, their blood will be on their own head. 5 Since they heard the sound of the trumpet but did not heed the warning, their blood will be on their own head. If they had heeded the warning, they would have saved themselves. 6 But if the watchman sees the sword coming and does not blow the trumpet to warn the people and the sword comes and takes someoneÂ's life, that personÂ's life will be taken because of their sin, but I will hold the watchman accountable for their blood.Â'

7 Â"Son of man, I have made you a watchman for the people of Israel; so hear the word I speak and give them warning from me. 8 When I say to the wicked, Â'You wicked person, you will surely die,Â' and you do not speak out to dissuade them from their ways, that wicked person will die for their sin, and I will hold you accountable for their blood. 9 But if you do warn the wicked person to turn from their ways and they do not do so, they will die for their sin, though you yourself w ill be saved.

10 Â"Son of man, say to the Israelites, Â'This is what you are saying: Â"Our offenses and sins weigh us down, and we a re wasting away because of them. How then can we live?Â"Â' 11 Say to them, Â'As surely as I live, declares the S overeign LORD, I take no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but rather that they turn from their ways and live. Turn! Turn from your evil ways! Why will you die, people of Israel?Â'

12 Â"Therefore, son of man, say to your people, Â'If someone who is righteous disobeys, that personÂ's forme r righteousness will count for nothing. And if someone who is wicked repents, that personÂ's former wickednes s will not bring condemnation. The righteous person who sins will not be allowed to live even though they were formerly righteous. A' 13 If I tell a righteous person that they will surely live, but then they trust in their righteous ness and do evil, none of the righteous things that person has done will be remembered; they will die for the evi I they have done. 14 And if I say to a wicked person, Â'You will surely die,Â' but they then turn away from their s in and do what is just and right— 15 if they give back what they took in pledge for a loan, return what they hav e stolen, follow the decrees that give life, and do no evil—that person will surely live; they will not die. 16 None of the sins that person has committed will be remembered against them. They have done what is just and right; they will surely live.
