-----Tragically, too many speak with tongues, but then live like the devil.

You know, I have a hard time believing this to be true.

Those who I know who have sinned (including myself), or failed God, or have in some way lost sight of the calling, I never see these brethren speak in tongues, in fact they avoid it because they feel so unworthy speaking in that language. I can't imagine anyone who has the gift of the Holy Ghost who has that ability to speak in tongues and live like the devil, it's hard to comprehend, I just haven't seen anyone to be like this do this.

Perhaps it's the ones that are faking it or another spirit is controlling them or these movements that are more into hype than holiness that everyone is thrown into the same pot.

I don't want to turn this into a debate whether or not tongues are for us today, that is not the purpose. What I wish to hear, if any can contribute, is your observation from those that you believe to have the genuine gift of tongues but they also live like the devil.

I was thinking this morning of people who have received the gift of tongues and doesn't seem to think twice about the sin in their life (i.e. living like the devil).

First, I wanted to say that that is between them and the Lord; they will have to give an account to God for that. Secondly, if you (or anyone) know someone personally who is living that way; I beseech you all to pray for them and pray about confronting them scripturally. I had a pastor years ago who said often, "It's a fearful thing to fall into the hands of the Living God and if you see someone heading into the direction of the hands of the Living God, you should be praying for mercy for them."

And this is what I was thinking about, 2 Thessalonians 2.10-12 and how it possibly applies, "because they RECEIVED NOT THE LOVE OF THE TRUTH, that they might be saved. And for this cause God shall send them strong delusion, that they should believe a lie: That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness."

I know a lot of people associate this verse with the end times but the Lord showed me that this is for my life; and I praised God when I began listening to Zac Poonen and he was teaching that also!! I was YES! I did not hear God wrong!!
