And also you can work on your own 'commentary' commenting on verses throughout the bible. Once you have the information into the database you can save and view it as a "pdf" document for easy printing and sharing with friends, its also a great way to store it. Its hoped that many pastors, teachers and laypeople will use this tool as a way to prepare and get their thoughts down digitally to share with others.

Thank you, brother Greg, for this wonderful module, I'll probably make much use of it. Not so much to show others, but to keep my own thoughts in order. Over the past couple years I've written many comments, but it's hard to keep track of where I've left them or to even remember that I've got them around sometimes. This way they're all in one place (and printable, if I need a hard copy), and I'll likely be reminded of them (to review, perhaps) every time I wander in to SI.

So far, the interface seems pretty good. The only exception is that, when I put in the usual "enter key" line breaks in the edit box, they don't show up on a normal view. If I want the line break to show up, I have to put in a `
` tag. The "enter key" line breaks are being saved, it seems, as they're there when the comment is reopened for editing.
