CHURCHES IN BELARUS KEEP GROWING IN SPITE OF GOVERNMENT POLICIES

Slavik Radchuk, Christian Aid MissionÂ's field director for the former Soviet Union, says that indigenous ministries in Bel arus are seeing Â"many more people come to the Lord than they have in a long time.Â"

This encouraging news comes even as reports continue to emerge from the country that government leadership is beco ming ever more dictatorial in nature since the country passed the most repressive religion law in Europe.

Government policies include severe restrictions on evangelical churches. All religious groups are required to register wit h the government, yet the registration process is so difficult that only Russian Orthodox, Roman Catholic and Jewish gro ups are eligible.

Non-registered evangelical churches are not allowed to construct church buildings unless they have at least 100 adult m embers who have signed official forms. Many churches struggle with facilitating growth since open-air evangelistic meeti ngs are illegal, as are house-church meetings with more than five people in attendance. Government policies also prohib it or make it difficult to rent space to evangelical church groups.
