North Korea confirmed Thursday that it is preparing to indict an American who is accused of proselytizing.

Jun Young-Su has been held since November, the NorthÂ's official Korean Central News Agency said.

The report did not state what crime he was accused of committing, but South Korean media have reported that an Ameri can was detained for spreading Christianity. He is the latest U.S. citizen to be detained in the reclusive communist state i n recent years.
