Note we do hold the same ideas on evangelism and gospel, but they have been opportunities to push the envelope into other areas. Being able to discuss what is poor about modern evangelism has encouraged us as we have a like mind to see the gospel preached, that people are convicted by the Holy Spirit, etc.

It's step by step forward, and would appreciate prayers on both of these things. It's important as the husband to hear the voice of God clearly, and to be able to discuss things freely with my wife. Praise God that there has been some good progress there, and we are able to talk these things through without heckles being raised in defence.
