Hi I was reading the geneology for 1 Chronicles and found it a bit confusing, for example in 1 Chron 4

The descendants of Judah:

Perez, Hezron, Karmi, Hur and Shobal.

- 2 Reaiah son of Shobal was the father of Jahath, and Jahath the father of Ahumai and Lahad. These were the clans of the Zorathites.
- 3 These were the sons of Etam:
- Jezreel, Ishma and Idbash. Their sister was named Hazzelelponi. 4 Penuel was the father of Gedor, and Ezer the father of Hushah.

These were the descendants of Hur, the firstborn of Ephrathah and father of Bethlehem.

- 5 Ashhur the father of Tekoa had two wives, Helah and Naarah.
- 6 Naarah bore him Ahuzzam, Hepher, Temeni and Haahashtari. These were the descendants of Naarah.
- 7 The sons of Helah:
- Zereth, Zohar, Ethnan, 8 and Koz, who was the father of Anub and Hazzobebah and of the clans of Aharhel son of Harum.
- 9 Jabez was more honorable than his brothers. His mother had named him Jabez, saying, Â"I gave birth to him i n pain.Â" 10 Jabez cried out to the God of Israel, Â"Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge my territory! Let y our hand be with me, and keep me from harm so that I will be free from pain." And God granted his request.

They dont seem to add up and random names come up from nowhere that seem to have no relation to the provi ous e.g. Etam and Jabez....
