Greetings,

With all that is happening in our world today, I found it necessary (by His Spirit) to search the Scriptures to find the parallel of that which was and that which is. It is amazing the truth of God's immutable attribute. "For I am the Lord, I change not: therefore ye sons of Jacob are not consumed." Malachi 3:6

God's consistent stretching out His hand to judge us, but not consume us is found throughout history from the Garden of Eden to now. And as He touches a people, the church, a family or individual it is that they might see their sin which provoked Him and confess it and repent of it.

And as men refuse to forsake their sin, the judgments get harder, nearer and more deadly. I found this truth in Leviticus 26:18, 'I will punish you seven times more for your sins.' Out of this passage I have identified for study, and prayer for our current place, seven levels of Judgment. Without a repentant church we will see literally 1000's of souls go out into eternity. And we know that they are not ready for eternity.
