A government agency that oversees charities in the United Kingdom has decided that a local Christian congregation can not be registered because it does not open its communion services to just any outsider.

The decision by the U.K.Â's Charity Commission is being reported by The Christian Institute, which has been working on the case of the Plymouth Brethren assembly in Devon for seven years.

The government has determined the group cannot be registered because it has decided that its communion services are for members only.

Â"During the evidence a letter from the commissionÂ's head of legal services emerged claiming that churches cannot be assumed to be acting for the public good, A" the report said. ...
