The term "Hindi" does not adequately describe the ethnic and social complexity of these people, since it is merely a language distinction. In reality, Hindi-speaking Indians are a collection of ethnic and social groups widely dispersed around the world. It is usually the higher castes and educated people who leave India and migrate to other countries. These people now hold a wide variety of occupations, and in Saudi Arabia many are employed as domestic helpers. As is common among most migratory groups, Hindi speakers have tended to congregate where there are other Hindi speakers. Hindi speakers in Saudi Arabia are primarily Hindu, but there are also many Muslims among them.

Ministry Obstacles

The government and people of Saudi Arabia are strongly resistant to any efforts to evangelize in their country, although efforts directed toward expatriates may be tolerated.

Outreach Ideas

Many expatriates in Saudi Arabia are Christians. Pray they will live attractive lives in the power of God's Spirit, which will bring honor to God among the Muslims and Hindus in the land.
