"The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.―

I am reconciled to a right relationship with God.†This is not necessarily the voice of God or a dream, although it may take those forms as well; but generally it is an intuiti ve knowing within one's heart, a "know that you know†experienceâ€" something that produces a strong and I asting faith; a deep

inner confidence that could endure all trials, tribulations, temptations, depressions, confusions, sufferings, and even mart yrdom for Christ.

Without this witness, there is no real faith, and hence no salvation; this is the undergirding power, and even the essence of saving faith.'
