Would you prayerfully consider joining a forum wide period of prayer and fasting for each of our respective communities ?

It is a loud song in my heart and thought it may be yours too that we could jointly fast and pray for this very pointed purp ose: that God will awaken the community of each one of us who participates, that He will raise a vocal and audible proph etic alarm in each of our communities for the church to repent of ungodliness and of lack of life-or-death seriousness ab out the things of God, and that believers and churches will respond in obedience to that prophetic call, and that whereve r repentance lacks that God will speak to any remnant in such a community and draw the few together there into fellows hip with one another in Him.
