I found it a bit bizarre. The crowd was well behaved BUT I think that is due to the nature of how the Watchtower groups these people to behave. I think of it as a Gestapo with the elders being the henchmen. The Elders were all over the place and didn't seem to want anyone on the perimeter of the room.

Something the JW's do not like to deal with is Romans 8:1. It reads a little differently in the NWT but it can still be used to provoke them. Ask any JW if they are anointed and most will say no.
