Just did a bit of reading about "angels" - quite interesting.

The Biblical meaning is not quite the same as the traditional "religious" meaning

"a messenger, envoy, one who is sent, an angel, a messenger from God "

John the Baptist was also an "angel" , a messenger

I think it is important to try and look at it in a wider context. We know that Jesus has now all power and authority in heaven and on earth.

Therefore I believe He is the author of the (godly ) messages.

He can send them in different ways, in a "natural " way through a preacher or through a dream or many other ways.

A very useful tool to find out how the word is used in the Bible is "Strongs Concordance "
