A couple days later I got a check in the mail for almost the exact amount I gave to him. (It was from Walmart to settle up on a problem I had with them.) God gave me many miracles for just one, broken down car! I immediately started to cry, being so overwhelmed with God's love for me.

Sorry this was so long but I just had to tell you the whole story.
