One take away for me is that there is a rising dissenting voice against the main stream narrative of the day, and that the â€œvoiceâ€ (at least in the video you linked to, and this one that I am linking to) does harken to those who associate with Christ Jesus.

That said, my perception is that Metaxas, and the folks in this interview, though both wanting to â€œtake a standâ€, have different ideologies about what that looks like.

Metaxas still sounds â€œpatrioticâ€, whereas the folks in this interview sound more â€œoutside the campâ€ as it were.

Then there is the video posted on SI the other day from the Bishop in Australia, which is yet another perspective, as he preaches about â€œfreedomsâ€ specifically in the context of the institution of the church, as practiced by him and his congregants. That is in addition to the freedoms heâ€™s advocating for on behalf of Australia as a whole (that aspect I perceive is similar to what Metaxas is promoting).

One undeniable commonality among them are their clarion calls to â€œtake a standâ€ or â€œtake actionâ€ and â€œspeak upâ€ or â€œrise upâ€, etc.

So, which voices are truly reflecting Godâ€™s heart in this hour?

All of them? None of them? Is anyone?
