And the outer anointing has no power to transform us but functions to transform others and bring deliverance , teachings and manifestations of power, this anointing is normally associated with the baptism of the spirit and the spiritual anointing that comes upon you to make one bold and flow with prophetic and apostolic gifts (ascension gift anointing).
