Ezekiel 22:23-31

As we read this passage we are faced with modern reality. Here there are three classes of people: The Priests, the Princes and the Prophets.

The Priests, responsible for teaching the law to the people, do not know how to differentiate right from wrong. Who never stopped to learn, will never know how to teach. Those who have never sat down to listen will never be able to speak.

Today's priests cannot teach the people, because they know nothing about right and wrong. They know more about Old Testament hero stories and less about the God of Heroes.

The description of this scenario, perhaps, resembles his. I don't just want to talk about the error, because identifying an error does not make us right. Many can see mistakes, but fail to do what is right.

The question is, does God look for Men to put in the gap. Can he count on you?

I have a cry for everyone who reads this meditation and feels this calling. Please get out of the entertainment, lock yourself in a room and seek the Lord.

It is time for us to seek God so that He will come down again and make us experience days like the old days.
